Obituary from the Olsburg (Kansas) News-Letter, September 20, 1894, p. 8:

**DIED.**

**LITTLETON H. BAKER** -- Was born March 12, 1819, in the state of Kentucky, and died at his home in Fostoria, Sep. 16th, 1894. He survived his wife, Mary Baker, six months and two days. They enjoyed together some fifty years of married life, and were the respective parents of fourteen children of which eleven - seven sons and four daughters are living.

He was a member of the Methodist church over forty years, and lived a consistent christian life, dying triumphantly in the faith. His funeral was held in the Fostoria Methodist church Monday at 10 a.m. Services were conducted by Rev. M. E. Stewart, pastor of the Olsburg charge.

The sermon was preached from Gen. 25th chapter, 7th to 10th verses. Hymns were sung from the "Finest Wheat," numbers 66, 187, 141, 151. Number 187 is an old hymn and one especially loved by the deceased.

His body now rests beneath the dust in the Olsburg cemetery, awaiting the resurrection morn.

Obituary posted to the GenForum Baker family forum 9/26/2005.

From the Westmoreland Recorder, Thursday September 20, 1894, p. 5: "Olsburg. Old Mr. Baker of Fostoria, was burried [sic] here Monday. Another of the old pioneers has gone to his reward."

From the Alliance News, September 21, 1894, p. 4: "L. H. Baker, an old and honored citizen of Fostoria, died last Sunday and was buried in Olsburg Monday. He was 75 years old. He hadn't recovered from a severe attack of la grip some years ago, whic h was probably the cause of his death. His wife died only last spring. The bereaved relatives have the sympathy of all."

Which said license is in the words and figures following, to-wit: State of Indiana, Marion county - To any person empowe red by law to solemnize marriages in the county of Marion, Greeting: You are hereby authorized to join together as husband and wife, Mr. Littleton H. Baker and Miss Mary Jackson according to the laws of the State of Indiana.

In testimony whereof, I, Robert B. Duncan, Clerk of the Circuit Court of said county, hereunto subscribe my name, and affix the seal of said Court, at Indianapolis, this 1st day of September A.D. 1846 RB Duncan By G. Booker [?]

The marriage of whom is thus certified: State of Indiana, Marion county. I, the undersigned, a Justice of the Peace in and for said County do hereby certify that Littleton H. Parker [sic] and Mary Jackson were legally joined together as husband and wife, on the Third day of September 1846, by me Noah McCrary [?]"
