EDWARDS, J. The plaintiff in error, hereinafter called defendant, was convicted in the district court of Tulsa county on a charge of robbery and was sentenced to serve a term of 10 years in the state penitentiary.

The record discloses that on August 22, 1925, a filling station on the outskirts of Tulsa, in charge of one Johnny Crowell, was held up and about \$25 taken from the cash register. A few days later defendant was arrested, charged with the offense. He is identified by Crowell as the person who committed the robbery. Defendant denied his guilt and offered evidence tending to prove an alibi.

Are Indicted For Rioting, The Nebraska State Journal, Friday, March 25, 1910, pg 1

Cairo Grand Jury Cathes Twelve In Its Net.

Cairo, Ill, March 24 - Twelve indicatments for rioting were returned this afternoon by a special grand jury that has been investigating the attack on the Alexander county jail, February 17, during which one man in the mob was killed, and several injured by the sheriff's special deputies. Those indicted are: George F. Walker, newspaper man; Frantz Gorman, an alderman; James Davidge, a constable; C. O. Foster, former deputy circuit clerk; Lee Watson, stock dealer; Samuel Wessinger (sic Wissinger), special agent of the Big Four Railroad and deputy sheriff; W.H. Simpson, manager of a lumber company; James Casey, former policeman; J.B. Scott, blacksmith; W.C. Charles, liveryman; O.P. Hurd, Jr., president of a lumber company; Jon Maloney, wagon manufacturer. The twelve were immediately arrested and released on bonds. Their trail has been set for May 9, and funds for their defense will be raised by popular subscription. The indictments caused a sensation as no such drastic action was anticipated. A fine of \$500 and six months imprisonment is possible in cases of conviction. The mob was repused while trying to take Jon Pratt, a negro purse-snatcher, from jail to lynch him. The grand jury is not through with its investigation, and further indictments may be returned.

CAIRO, Ill. -- James R. "Jimmy" Wissinger, 78, of Cairo passed away Tuesday, Jan. 3, 2006, at Southeast Missouri Hospital in Cape Girardeau.

He was born Nov. 2, 1927, in Cairo, son of Lloyd "Pete" and Stella Mae Brimm. He and Ann Dyas were married Dec. 16, 1948.

Mr. Wissinger was a pressman 20 years at Cairo Evening Citizen. He later sold insurance for Metropolitan Life Insurance and Franklin Life Insurance companies. He was also a professional photographer for the Cairo Evening Citizen and area businesses and events. He was employed by city of Cairo under Mayor Al Moss.

He had served several terms over the years as a Cairo city council member and as Alexander County commissioner. He also served 58 years with Cairo Auxiliary Fire Department, serving in the position of assistant fire chief.

He was also a member of the board of directors who organized the Shawnee Development Council. Mr. Wissinger had also been honored by the Cairo Jaycees as the Man of the Year.

He was a lifelong resident of Cairo, and was a true advocate of his hometown at all times and with all people. Mr. Wissinger was also a lifetime member of Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 2649, having served his country in the U.S. Army in occupied Japan following World War II. He was a member of Tigert Memorial United Methodist Church in Cairo.

Mr. Wissinger is survived by his wife of 57 years, Ann Wissinger of Cairo; a daughter, Judy Nordman (Ernie) of Cape Girardeau; four sons, Randy Wissinger (Linda) of New Berlin, Wis., Jeff Wissinger (Mary Helen) of Cairo, Alec Wissinger (Diane) of Thompsonville, Ill., John Paul Wissinger (Lisa) of Cape Girardeau; a sister, Mary Elizabeth Johnson of Leander, Texas; 13 grandchildren; 12 great-grandchildren; other relatives and many friends.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Wissinger was preceded in death by his great-aunt and great-uncle, Lizzie and Frank Youch.
