"In the line of descent from the immigrant Adam Brouwer Berckhoven and his wife Magdalena Jacobs Verdon, through their son Abraham and his wife Leah de Marest; and then their son Jacobus, bp. DRC, Hackensack, 1 May 1709, who married Jannetje Hartje - - there are a number of Duryea spouses and a marriage in the New York Dutch Church of Jacobus' daughter Jannetje (Jane) to Jacob Vredenburg on Oct. 23, 1769. Jane's brother John was born about 1750 (died April 12, 1823, 73 years old according to NY Evening Post), and married Catherine Duryea. The last of John's and Catherine's seven known children was Jacob Vredenburg Brouwer, bo. Feb. 25, bp. New York Dutch Church, Mar. 7, 1796. Other known sons of John were John
