The cemetery is located on the old Brower homestead (not now in Brower hands), in Jefferson Township, Miami County, Indiana. About two miles North of the old dunkard Church, which is located in Mexico, Indiana in Section #31.

Ara Lena (Aralena?) Brower, Dau. of J. & E. Brower, died February 13,  
1858, aged 24 days.

William H Brower, son of J & E Brower, died August 14, 1860, aged 20 yrs  
8 mos 25 days. Poetry. Large Monument.

Rebecca (Brower?) Dau. of J & E Brower, died October 9, 1864, aged 22 yrs  
9 mos 22 days. Poetry.

Lovina (Brower), Dau. of J & E Brower, died January 19, 1869, aged  
25 yrs 6 days. Poetry: "Sister, thou (wert?) mild and lovely,  
gentle as the summer breeze, pleasant as the air of heaven, when  
it floats among the trees."

Samuel C (G?) Brower, son of J & E Brower, died November 2, 1869 aged  
21 yrs 2 mos 21 days. "Thy passing spirit sustained by grace, etc."

Sarah E Brower, September 20, 1870 to September 23, 1870 "Dearest  
sister".

Jno. Lesley Co B, 40th Ind Inf. (In a long, curbed burial lot).

"U. B." (small stone at badly sunken grave on north limit of curbed  
lot).

Allice K Jones, Daughter of D. & M. A., died May 8, 1855, aged 1 yrs  
1 mo 12 days.

William S Tuttle, died January 22, 1872, aged 40 yrs 4 mos

Effie May Tuttle, daughter of W. H. & S., died August 16, 1871

"J. R." (Small, displaced footstone).

Alonzo Tuttle, son of W. H. & S Tuttle, died March 24, 1864, aged  
4 mos.

(Infant) Tuttle, child of W. H. & S. Tuttle, died July 23, 1859, aged  
25 days

(Infant) Tuttle, son of W. H. & S. Tuttle, died July 15, 1859, aged 16 days

Jacob O Tuttle, son of W. H. & S., died September 20, 1858, aged 6 mos  
6 days

Mary Brower died September 3, 1845, aged 85 yrs 1 mo (Mrs J. Brower,  
Sen.)

Isaiah Brower, son of G. & S. Brower, died September 22, 1846, aged  
8 yrs 10 mos 9 days

Jacob Brower, died March 30, 1867, aged 75 yrs 4 mos 2 days

Elisabeth (Mrs Jacob) Brower, died April 25, 1860 aged 68 yrs 4 (1?)mos  
6 days

Abraham Brower, died February 28, 1857, aged 32 yrs 4 mos 12 days.

Mary (Mrs David) Moss, died August 21, 1854 aged 34 yrs 11 mos 10  
days

Jacob Teal Brower, son of J & E Brower, died February 16, 1861, aged  
27 yrs 1 mo.

George Brower "Father", died May 22, 1888, aged 89 yrs 1 mo. Poetry  
says his soul is safe in heaven, etc.

Sarah Brower "Mother", died July 3, 1872, aged 69 yrs 1 mo 18 days.  
"And when I close my eyes in death and creature comforts all  
flee, then, O my great Redeemer God, I pray, remember me."

Sarah Brower (Wife of Reverend George), died July 3, 1872, aged 69 yrs  
1 mo 18 days. Poetry. (Evidently the same as for Sarah Brower  
Above).

Jacob Swihart, died September 23, 1881, aged 71 yrs 26 days

Amanda M. (Mrs Irs) Sayger, died November 28, 1868, aged 32 yrs 8 mos  
7 days

Alyann (Mrs William) Sayger, died May 6, 1864, aged 24 (31?) yrs 7 mos  
13 days. Poetry. "You are most near and dear to me, I have you  
in my heart."

Elizabeth Sayger, daughter of G. & M. M. Sayger, died May 31, 1854, aged  
18 yrs 6 mos 25 days.

Levi Wolf, son of G. W. & E. Wolf; died August 4, 1856, aged 2 yrs  
1 mo 18 days

Martha A Wilkinson, daughter of J. & S. Wilkinson, died August 28,  
1855, aged 1 mo 28 days. "This was a jewel lent to me.....etc".

Mrs Jacob Wilkinson (Mary Wilkinson), died June 18, 1850, aged 30 yrs  
7 mo 22 days (Broken at date)

Frances (Mrs Nathaniel) Clingenpeel, died September 8, 1846, aged  
55 yrs 1 mo

Nathaniel Clingenpeel, died July 6, 1874, aged 81 yrs 10 mo 4 days

Hannah Sayger, daughter of P & S Sayger, died July 18, 1841, aged  
1 yrs 6 mos 3 days

John G (C?) Lindsay, son of J W & H Lindsay, died June 10, 1859, aged  
2 yrs 4 mos 7 days

Irs M. S. Lindsay, son of J W & H Lindsay, died January 14 (11?), 1859  
aged 6 days

Omar P Lindsay, son of J W & H (N?) Lindsay, died May 27, 1857, aged  
3 yrs 2 mos 14 days

Emily (Pisel), daughter of J M & B A Pisel, died April 30, 1861, aged  
3 yrs 5 mos 18 days. "And we know her soul is in heaven,.....etc"

Effie Viola Slaybaugh, daughter of M & S, died September 21, 1861, aged  
2 yrs 8 mos 15 days

Julian Deniston, daughter of M & A, died May 15, 1840 aged 11 years  
13 days

Susannah Brower, died January 12, 1865, aged 63 yrs 5 mos 24 days.  
"I have fought a good fight, etc"

Elizabeth Brower, died January 15, 1871, aged 68 yrs 1 mo 21 days.,  
"As for me, I will beheld thy face,...etc" Ps 17, Chap 15, V(?)

Margret Brower, died March 29, 1875, aged 49 yrs 6 mos 15 days. Poetry.  
"Search the Scripture....."

(Infant Brower), son of D & M E, died June 15, 1862, aged 15 days

Benjamin F Brower, son of H. & R., died November 14, 1866, aged 6 yrs  
6 mos 9 days. (This stone is fallen, broken and probably dis-  
placed from the grave where it belongs).

Uriah Brower, son of J. & A., died July 28, 1866, aged 19 yrs 9 mos  
12 days

C (ornelius?) Brower, son of J. & A., died June 1, 1869 (1889?), aged 21 yrs 1 mo 25 days. (This monument was broken into four fragments, scattered in various parts of the cemetery).

Silas Brower, son of J. & A., died February 22, 1864, aged 13 yrs 9 mos 2 days

Maria Brower, daughter of H. & R., died April 19, 1863, aged 16 yrs 1 mo 14 days. Poetry.

John H Brower, son of J. & A., died September 14, 1854, aged 1 yr 6 mos 10 days

Joseph Brower, died February 2, 1857, aged 41 yrs 9 mos 8 days. Poetry.  
 "O tell my companion and children most dear....the same Hand that has led me through scenes dark and drear had kindly conducted me, etc."

Anna (Mrs Joseph) Brower, August 22, 1816 - December 21, 1900

Salome Brower, died January 22, 1864, aged 55 yrs, 9 mos, 20 days.  
 "And I heard a voice from heaven, saying.....etc"

Hannah (Mrs H.) Brower, died September 12, 1853, aged 72 yrs 10 mos 3 days

Henry Brower, died June 29, 1842, aged 64 yrs 5 mos 21 days

Katharine Grafft, daughter of B. & H., died September 1, 1854, aged 1 yrs 4 mos 9 days

Cornelius Rush, died May 6, 1857, aged 29 yrs 11 mos 8 days

John Rush, died May 9, 1848, aged 52 yrs 5 mos 9 days

Elizabeth ( Mrs John ) Rush, died October 6, 1845, aged 60 years 3 mos 12 days

\_\_\_\_\_(?)(Rush?), date of death obliterated, aged \_\_\_\_\_(?) 5 (9?) mos 23 days. The given name may possibly be Saloma, or Ghidina, or Saliuda. This stone is broken into two pieces and the inscription is almost illegible. It either says "Dau. of" or "Wife of".

Mary Ann Rush, died March 2, 1857 aged 7 yrs 8 mos 26 days

Elizabeth Rush, died March 26, 1857, aged 15 yrs 5 mos 8 days

S. E. Koler (Wife of William) Collett, born November 14, 1823, and died March 26, 1856. (Large old monument, but fallen)

C. B. (No surname or dates, and may be displaced)

Etta L. Collett, daughter of Wm. & Mary, died September 23, 1862, aged  
1 mo 28 days. Poetry.

Susannah (Mrs Jacob) Dillman, died October 15, 1860, aged 77 years

Anna (Mrs G) Shoemaker (Almost illegible. Field worker thinks month  
of death starts with either "O" (October) or "S" (September), but  
is not sure)
