Descendants of Dr. Richard Bard

First Generation

1. **Dr. Richard Bard**¹ was born on 13 Apr 1811 near Cincinnati, Hamilton, Ohio,^{2,3} died on 12 Aug 1880 in Boulder, CO³ at age 69, and was buried in Columbia Cemetery, Boulder, Colorado.³

General Notes: 'Dr. Bard has moved to town with his family.' (Boulder News 29 Mar 1870) Dr. R. Bard, Eclectic Physician and oculist, office at Fonda's Drug Store; residence on Harden Farm (BCN 3 May 1872) Granddau Charlotte Collie wrote, 'I suppose my grandfather Bard was as eccentric a man as ever lived. Born in Hamilton, OH, from the Pre-Revolutionary Bards who settled in New York. Richard and his son Edward came to Colorado first in 1859 or 1860. Uncle Edward Bard served in the 2nd Colorado Volunteers going from Empire, CO where he and Grandfather were living then. Grandfather went back to Iowa, having laid out the the town of Empire, and named it 'Valley City.' He was an ardent Democrat and named Democrat Mountain & Douglas Peak near Empire, and I understand that Bard Creek and Bard Peak honor his name. When peace came he came back to Colorado with his family in 1866 (by covered wagon & oxen) and followed 'the valley' up to Boulder. When she (daughter Mary) was married, Grandfather Bard was outraged - I think scarcely spoke to her, but it was my father, Joseph Collie, who looked after his Masonic dues, his last illness in Boulder & erected the first marble tombstone in the Columbia Lodge Cemetery on the Collie lot. Uncle Ed Bard is also buried there, as it Mary Bard Collie and we shall have our ashes there.' Dr. Bard is best remembered as Boulder County's pioneer physician. See a paper read before the Boulder Territorial Pioneer Association Oct 15, 1932 about Dr. Bard. Carnegie Library has pamphlets written by Dr. Richard Bard including; Mysteries Revealed:Astronomy and Geology Harmonized with the Bible.' (Nov 2002 update)³

Additional events in his life were:

- He has conflicting birth information of 13 Apr 1811 and Hamilton, Ohio.³
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1840 in Jones, Hancock, Indiana.⁴ Richard, age 20-29, is living with 3 females under 5 (probably Melvina, Amanda and Luisa) and one female 20-29 (probably Mary). He is engaged in agriculture.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1850 in Mackanaw, McLean, Illinois.² He is living with his wife Mary and their children Melvina, Amanda, Suisa, Edward, Ellen and Ervin. He is a doctor.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Douglas, Boone, Iowa.⁵ He is living with his wife Mary and their children Ellen, Ervin, Calvin, Mary and Edward. He is working as a physician. His personal property is worth \$500.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1870 in Boulder, Boulder, Colorado Territory.⁶ He is living with his wife Mary, his son Ervin and daughter Mary. Ervin is listed as head of household. Richard is listed as a laborer, but the original entry is crossed out and illegible.

Richard married **Mary Sheury**⁸ on 3 Jul 1834 in Hancock County, Indiana.^{3,7} Mary was born on 8 Jun 1811 near Reading, Berks, Pennsylvania^{2,3} and died on 29 Mar 1872 in 1 mile east of Boulder, Colorado^{3,8} at age 60. The cause of her death was Apoplexy, found dead in bed.³ Another name for Mary was Mary Scheury.^{1,3}

Additional events in her life were:

- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1840 in Jones, Hancock, Indiana.⁴ Mary is probably living with Richard and her three oldest daughters.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1850 in Mackanaw, McLean, Illinois.² She is living with her husband Richard and their children.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Douglas, Boone, Iowa.⁵ She is living with her husband Richard and their children.

- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1870 in Douglas, Boone, Iowa.⁶ She is living with her husband Richard, her son Ervin and daughter Mary. She is working as a house keeper.

Louisa married **Granville Bunn**^{8, 12} (b. 16 Oct 1832).

2. Malvina Bard⁸ (*Richard (Dr.)*¹) was born on 22 Dec 1835 in Indiana⁹ and died on 12 Jan 1919 in Nebraska or Iowa⁹ at age 83. Another name for Malvina was Melvina Bard.¹

Additional events in her life were:

- She has conflicting birth information of 28 Dec 1835.⁸ Monday
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1840 in Jones, Hancock, Indiana.⁴ Melvina is probably living with her parents and her two younger sisters Amanda and Luisa. She would be under 5 years old.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1850 in Mackanaw, McLean, Illinois.² She is 14 years old and living with her parents.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Steady Run, Keokuk, Iowa.¹⁴ She is living with her husband and two sons.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1870 in North Platte City, Lincoln County, Nebraska.¹⁵ She is living with her husband and family. She is keeping house.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1880 in North Platte City, Lincoln County, Nebraska.¹⁶ She is living with her husband and three children. She is keeping house.
- She traveled to attend Daniel Martin's Ninetieth Birthday on 26 Apr 1889 in Martinsburg, Keokuk, Iowa.⁹

- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1910 in 1206 Locust St., Des Moines, Polk, Iowa.¹⁷ She is a widow and living alone as a boarder in the home of Virgil and Sadie Morris. She has no children with her and she is not working. She is 74 years old. She lists her father as being from Ohio and her mother from Pennsylvania.

Malvina married **Daniel Lafayette Martin**,¹ son of **Daniel Martin** and **Sarah Hagan**, on 25 Jul 1856 in Alexandria, Clark, MO.¹ Daniel was born on 13 Feb 1829 in Licking County, Ohio,^{9, 18} died on 9 May 1881 in North Platte, Lincoln, Nebraska^{9, 19} at age 52, and was buried in North Platte, Lincoln, Nebraska.⁹ Another name for Daniel was Daniel T Martin.¹⁸

Additional events in his life were:

- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1850 in Newark, Licking, Ohio.¹⁸ He is living with his parents and working as a farmer.
- He came to Martins Burg, Iowa in 1854
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Steady Run, Keokuk, Iowa.¹⁴ He is living with his wife Melvina and two children. He is working as a butcher. His real estate is worth \$1000 and his personal property \$250. His brother, Richard, is living with him. Richard is born 1836 Ohio and is working as a farmer.
- He was employed 1869 to 1887.¹ In August 1869 the family moved to North Platte, Nebraska, where the father followed his trade as a butcher, and in later years, that of a nurse, in which line he was much in demand, for in those early days along the frontier, there were no trained nurses.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1870 in North Platte City, Lincoln County, Nebraska.¹⁵ He is living with his wife and family. He is working as a day laborer. No value was given for his property. Based upon the children's birthplaces, sometime between 1862 and 1867 the family moved from Iowa to Nebraska.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1880 in North Platte, Lincoln, Nebraska.¹⁶ He is living with his wife Malvina, and three children. Edward has apparently left home. He is working as a butcher. His health description indicates that he is a paralytic.
- He had a residence in 1887 in Omaha, NE.¹ The family returned to Omaha, NE in 1887 where they have made their home since.

- 12 M ii. **Edward L Martin**¹ was born on 7 Jun 1859 in Martinsburg, Keokuk Co., Iowa,⁹ died on 18 Jan 1923 in Terre Haute, Indiana⁹ at age 63, and was buried in Terre Haute, Indiana.⁹
- 13 F iii. **Louella Martin**¹ was born on 25 Sep 1861 in Martinsburg, Keokuk Co., Iowa,^{9, 15}
Louella married **Joseph Higginson**²¹ (b. Abt 1862, d. 30 Jul 1926) on 19 Nov 1889.^{9, 21}

- 15 F v. **Frances "Fanny" F Martin**^{9, 22} was born on 6 Apr 1866 in Kearney, NE⁹ and died after 1939.²³
Frances married **Joseph Leslie Anderson**^{22, 24} (b. Nov 1862, d. 1952) on 27 May 1883 in Lincoln County, Nebraska.

3. **Amanda Bard**² (*Richard (Dr.)*¹) was born in Oct 1837 in Indiana^{2, 10} and died on 12 Jul 1916⁸ at age 78.

Additional events in her life were:

- She has conflicting birth information of 6 Oct 1837.⁸ Friday
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1840 in Jones, Hancock, Indiana.⁴ Amanda is probably living with her parents and 2 sisters Melvina and Luisa. She would be under 5 years old.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1850 in Mackanaw, McLean, Illinois.² She is living with her parents.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Palmyra, Warren, Iowa.²⁵ She is 28 years old and living with her husband Oscar and their children Samuel and Mary.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1870 in Atchison Ward 2, Atchison, Kansas.¹¹ She is 33 and living with her husband John Clarke. Mary, child by her first husband is living with them and she has the surname Clarke. Two children who appear to be with her husband John are Melvina and Julia. She is keeping house.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1880 in Kearney St., Atchison City, Atchison, Kansas.²⁶ She is 42 and living with her husband John and their children Melvina, Julia, William and Florence. She is keeping house.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1900 in College Ave., Washington, Washington, Kansas.¹⁰ She is 62 and living with her son Samuel. He was originally born Samuel Lundy, but now uses Clarke. He may have been adopted by Amanda's second husband John Clarke. Amanda is a widow and not working. She states she has borne 1 child with 1 living. This appears to be in error, but perhaps not.

Amanda married **Oscar Lundy**⁸ on 10 Nov 1853.⁸ Oscar was born about 1832 in Virginia.²⁵

Additional events in his life were:

- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Palmyra, Warren, Iowa.²⁵ He is 28 and living with his wife and children. Eveline Lundy, 34, b. abt 1826 Virginia is living with them and probably is his sister. He owns his home worth \$400 and is a carpenter.

Children from this marriage were:

16 M i. **Samuel Lundy**²⁵ was born in Aug 1854 in Iowa²⁵ and died before 1930.²⁷

Samuel married **Mary Anne Williamson**^{10, 29} (b. Dec 1857) in 1879 in Washington, Washington County, Kansas.^{10, 28}

17 F ii. **Mary J Lundy**²⁵ was born about 1856 in Iowa.²⁵

Amanda next married **John W Clarke**^{8, 11} about 1865. John was born about 1830 in Virginia.¹¹

Additional events in his life were:

- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1870 in Atchison Ward 2, Atchison, Kansas.¹¹ He is 30 and living with his wife, adopted? daughter Mary and children Melvina and Julia. He is a carpenter and owns his home valued at \$1000.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1880 in Kearney St., Atchison City, Atchison, Kansas.²⁶ He is 50 and living with his wife Amanda and their children. He is a carpenter. His parents are from Virginia.

Children from this marriage were:

18 F i. **Melvina Clarke**¹¹ was born about 1866 in Kansas.¹¹

4. **Louisa Bard**⁸ (*Richard (Dr.)*¹) was born on 30 Jan 1839 in Indiana.⁸ Another name for Louisa was Luisa Bard.²

Birth Notes: Saturday

Additional events in her life were:

- She has conflicting birth information of 1841 and Indiana.²
- She appeared on the US Census census in 1840 in Jones, Hancock, Indiana.⁴ Luisa is probably living with her parents, her older sisters Melvina and Amanda.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1850 in Mackanaw, McLean, Illinois.² She is living with her parents.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Center, Madison, Iowa.³⁰ She is 20 and living with her husband Granville and daughter Hazel. She states she was born in Ohio.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1870 in Jackson, Guthrie, Iowa.³¹ She is 30 years old and living with her husband Granville. They have no children. She states she was born in Illinois. She has no listed occupation.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1880 in Elk, Nuckolls, Nebraska.³² She is 41 and living with her husband Granville. They have no children. She is keeping house. They have a boarder. She states she was born in Indiana with her mother born in Pennsylvania and her father in Virginia [neither is correct].
- She appeared on the Nebraska State census in 1885 in Elk Precinct, Nuckolls, Nebraska.³³ She is living with her husband Granville. She is 45 years old and born in Indiana.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1900 in Elk, Nuckolls, Nebraska.³⁴ She is 61, a widow and living alone. She is not working. Whether she rents or owns is not provided. She was married 35 years. She has borne 0 children with 0 living.

Louisa married **Granville Bunn**,^{8, 12} son of **John Bunn** and **Eleanor Wilkinson**. Granville was born on 16 Oct 1832 in Grand Prairie, Marion County, Ohio.¹²

Additional events in his life were:

- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Center, Madison, Iowa.³⁰ He is 25 and living with his wife Louisa and daughter Hazel. He is a farmer and his property is valued at \$2000.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1870 in Jackson, Guthrie, Iowa.³¹ He is 34 and living with his wife Louisa. He is a farmer and lists the value of his real estate at \$100 and his personal property at \$800.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1880 in Elk, Nuckolls, Nebraska.³² He is 44 and living with his wife Louisa. They have no children. They have a boarder Marion Eaton, 29, b Indiana, parents Ohio, working as a farmer. Granville is working as a farmer. His father is born in Pennsylvania and his mother in NC.
- He appeared on the Nebraska State census in 1885 in Elk Precinct, Nuckolls, Nebraska.³³ He is 49 and living with his wife Louisa. He is born in Ohio.

The child from this marriage was:

22 F i. **Hazel Bunn**³⁰ was born in Mar 1860 in Iowa³⁰ and died before 1870.³¹

5. **Edward Bard**² (*Richard (Dr.)*¹) was born on 25 Nov 1841 in Illinois^{2, 3, 8} and died on 31 Dec 1915 in Monte Vista, Colorado³ at age 74. The cause of his death was Senility & long use of morphine.

General Notes: 'Edward Barb who died at Monte Vista Saturday at the Soldiers and Sailors home, was brought here today. Interment was made in Columbia Cemetery this afternoon in charge of J.G. - He appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Douglas, Boone, Iowa.⁵ He is living with his parents and attending school. His occupation is not legible.
- He served in the military in the Civil War.³ Private, Company E, 2nd Regiment Colorado Infantry / Calvary.
- He appeared on the Colorado State Census census in 1885 in Chaffee County, Colorado.³⁵
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1900 in Breckenridge, Summit, Colorado.³⁶ He is living alone and owns his own home. He is working as a miner of ores and metals. He is single and has no children.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1910 in Colorado Soldiers and Sailors Home, Rio Grande, Colorado.³⁷ He is living as an inmate. He is not working. He is single.

6. **Oliver Bard**⁸ (*Richard (Dr.)* ¹) was born on 7 Feb 1843 ⁸ and died on 13 Oct 1845 ⁸ at age 2.

Death Notes: Died Tuesday, aged 1 year, 8 months, 4 days.

General Notes: May be Olivia, female. See letter from Sade Clarke to Charlotte Collie.⁸

7. **Ellen Bard**² (*Richard (Dr.)* ¹) was born in 1846 in Illinois² and died on 8 Oct 1870 ⁸ at age 24.

Death Notes: Died Thursday, aged 24 years, 2 months, 26 days.

Additional events in her life were:

- She has conflicting birth information of 13 Jul 1846.⁸ Saturday
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1850 in Mackanaw, McLean, Illinois.² She is living with her parents.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Douglas, Boone, Iowa.⁵ She is living with her parents and attending school.

Ellen married **Koehler**.⁸

8. **Irvin Bard**^{8, 13} (*Richard (Dr.)* ¹) was born on 9 Dec 1848.⁸ Another name for Irvin was Ervin Bard.

Additional events in his life were:

- He has conflicting birth information of 1849 and Illinois.²
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1850 in Mackanaw, McLean, Illinois.² He is living with his parents.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Douglas, Boone, Iowa.⁵ He is living with his parents and attending school.

Descendants of Dr. Richard Bard

- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1870 in Boulder, Boulder, Colorado Territory.⁶ Edward is head of household and living with his parents and sister Mary. He is working as a laborer.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1880 in Boulder, Colorado.³⁸ He is living as a servant or as a boarder. He works as a waiter. He is single.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1910 in 1423? Market St., 2-Wd Denver, Denver, Colorado.¹³ He is single and living as a lodger. He works as a dishwasher in a restaurant.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1920 in 1446 12th Street, Denver, Denver, Colorado.³⁹ He is living alone and is listed as a widow. He is not working.

9. Calvin Bard⁵ (*Richard (Dr.)*¹) was born in 1851 in Illinois.⁵

Additional events in his life were:

- He has conflicting birth information of 18 Jul 1851.⁸
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1860 in Douglas, Boone, Iowa.⁵ He is living with his parents and attending school.
- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1870 in Boulder, Boulder, Colorado Territory.⁴⁰ He is living in the household of Clark Miner. He appears to be single and working as a laborer. He has no property of value.

10. Mary Elizabeth Bard^{3,5} (*Richard (Dr.)*¹) was born on 5 Sep 1853 in Palmyra, Iowa^{3,5} and died on 8 Dec 1912 in University Hospital, Boulder, Colorado³ at age 59. The cause of her death was Carcinoma of uterus of 2 years.

General Notes: Mary was one of the pioneers of Boulder. She crossed the plains in a prairie schooner from Palmyra, IA in 1867 with her parents. Her father, Dr. Bard, was a preacher and physician and author. Mary was granted a teacher's certificate and was a teacher in one of the mountain towns. She met Joseph Collie there. After his death she kept the hotel at Wall Street for 10 years. She and her children moved to Boulder in 1898. She was active in the Congregational Church. Her death 'ended a career which has been notable for kind deeds and many acts of useful and Christian service.' Two children survive - Ned Collie of Shawmut mine 180 miles from San Francisco, and Miss Charlotte Collie who came last week from Idaho Springs where she is a high school teacher. She is a CU graduate. Funeral at Congregational Church. Note: Her husband Joseph T. Collie died 31 Mar 1886 Franklinville, NY of heart trouble. Born 7 Mar 1847, son of James & Elizabeth (Watson) Collie. He had gone back east in the fall of 1885 for his health. His father sent a dispatch of his death to Mr. Sawyer in Boulder. Joseph left a wife and two children. Joseph had a \$500 Gold Hill mining claim. Mary was administratrix of his estate. (HW 31 Mar 1886:8; EF) It is likely that Joseph is not buried in Boulder but in Franklinville. (Nov 2002 update)

- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1880 in Salina, Boulder, Colorado.⁴¹ She is living with her husband Joseph Collie and their son "George". George is probably Joseph Edward. Her husband's sister Elizabeth is also living with them.
- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1900 in 1034 Pine St., Boulder, Boulder, Colorado.⁴² She is a widow and living with her two children Joseph and Charlotte. She is

renting her home and is not working.

- She appeared on the US Federal census in 1910 in 1034 Pine St., Boulder, Boulder, Colorado.⁴³ She is living alone and not working. She is renting the same house as in 1900.

Mary married **Joseph T Collie**.³ Joseph was born on 7 Mar 1847 in Scotland^{3, 41} and died on 31 Mar 1886 in Franklinville, NY³ at age 39.

Additional events in his life were:

- He appeared on the US Federal census in 1880 in Salina, Boulder, Colorado.⁴¹ He is living with his wife Mary and his son "George". His sister, Elizabeth, is also living with them. He is working as a miner and his parents are from Scotland.

Children from this marriage were:

- 23 M i. **Joseph Edward 'Ned' Collie**³ was born on 16 Mar 1879 in Sugarloaf, Colorado,³ died on 13 Dec 1958 in Nevada City, California^{3, 44} at age 79, and was buried on 2 Jan 1959.³
- 24 F ii. **Charlotte M Collie**³ was born on 2 Jun 1884 in Sugarloaf, Colorado³ and died on 25 Dec 1980 in Denver, Colorado^{3, 45} at age 96.

Washington Register. -- This new and brisk young candidate for journalistic honors was first issued April 10, 1880, by Dr. Charles Williamson and Samuel Clarke, its place of publication being Palmer. In August it was removed to Washington city. In July, 1882, W. A. Clark became associated with Mr. Clarke, Dr. Williamson retiring. On September, 1882, the Register commenced to issue a small daily, devoted to the wants of Washington City. This is claimed to be the first regular daily paper ever issued in the county, its only possible competitor for this honor being a campaign sheet issued by M. J. Kelley and J. O. Young, from October 19 to November, 8, 1870. It was not the intention to make the latter enterprise permanent. The Daily Register suspended after a brief season. The Register is Republican in politics, a seven column folio in form, and is edited and published by an energetic and practical firm of young men.

William G. Cutler's was first published in 1883 by A. T. Andreas, Chicago, IL.

Charles W. Clarke, a popular young attorney of Washington, Kan., was born in the city where he now resides, April 4, 1888. He is a son of Samuel and Mary A. Williamson Clarke, the former a native of Virginia and the mother of Kansas. Samuel Clarke came to Kansas with his parents when a boy about eight years of age. This was in 1860. The Clarke family first settled in Atchison and in 1880 removed to Washington county and settled in the town of Washington, where the father has been engaged in the newspaper business ever since. He is now the editor and owner of the Washington "Palladium," one of the leading newspapers of northern Kansas.

Charles W. Clarke attended the public schools of Washington, and after two years in the high school entered the Washington Academy. He then clerked two years in a drug store in Washington, and in 1907 matriculated at the Kansas University,[sic] where he graduated in the class of 1909 with the degree of Pharmaceutical Chemist, and the following year was employed as a pharmacist in St. Joseph, Mo. In the fall of 1910 he returned to the Kansas University and entered the law department, and was graduated in the class of 1913 with the degree of Bachelor of Laws. During the time that he was studying law in the university he was also engaged as custodian of the pharmaceutical division, and in this manner paid his own way through the law school. 'Collie' does not appear on any stone.' Her uncle Edward Bard has a G.A.R. stone. 'I am the last of my family and shall want my ashes interred with my brother and mother. The Waggoner 1/4 lot was settled in my Mother's lifetime.' Charles W.V. Feigel (secretary of Park Cemetery

Association) wrote a letter to Charlotte 5 Aug 1932. Mr. Weaver was caretaker. (City Central Records) Her only close relative was her brother J.E. 'Ned' Collie who died 1958. Granddau of Dr. & Mrs. Richard Bard, pioneers in Empire and Boulder, CO. Bard Creek and Peak in Clear Creek County are named for them. Charlotte graduated from State Preparatory School in Boulder and from the Univ of Colorado in 1906. She taught school in Idaho Springs and in Denver. She made many contributions of photos, etc to the Boulder Historical Society and Western History in Norlin Library, CU campus. There were no services for Charlotte. Her ashes were buried in the family plot in Columbia cem. (Nov 2002 update)³
