Johann Friedrich Wilhelm Amelung died at the home of his son-in-law, Peter Volkman, in Baltimore. Files located in town offices of Newstadt/Ruebengerge, Hannover, Germany, indicate that Johann Amelung, mortgaged excessively the farm of his father-in-law, Border Guard, Christian Leseberg, and therefore surrendered its management. Amelung then moved to his brother, Anton, in Grunenplan, to help him in the direction of his mirror works. In about 1784, he sold his farm to satisfy his creditors and in the same year emigrated from Bremen to the U.S.A. It was his intention to found a glass factory in his new home. Amelung arrived in Baltimore, Maryland on August 31, 1784, and founded the New Bremen Glass Works in nearby Frederick, Maryland. He built and lived in the Amelung mansion known as "Montevino," at the foot of Sugar Loaf mountain near Urbana, Maryland. The house is still standing. He was a naturalized American citizen and voted in the elections of 1796.

Other publications deal with the troubled history and fires of the glass manufactory. The business failed and it was auctioned off June 18, 1804. Collections of Amelung glass may be seen at Corning Museum, Corning, NY, the Maryland Historical Society, Baltimore, Maryland. Many other museums such as the Metropolitan, NYC, Winterthur, Wilmington, Del., Connecticut Historical Society, Hartford, Connecticut, own one or a few pieces. Some settlers from more northern Germany reached our area especially during and after the Revolutionary War, including pastors, so-called Hessian solders and glass workers of

John F. Amelung. The distinguished Amelung name comes from the first, almost mythical ruling family of the East Goths in the early centuries. Amelung was able to start manufacturing glass quickly at New Bremen near Sugar Loaf Mountain by buying the earlier glassworks of a more humble south German group headed by Conrad Voltz (Foltz). A name from New Bremen deserving to be more famous still remains to be discovered, that of the artist and engraver of the Amelung presentation goblets.
