He married **(2) Wilhelmine Woelkener** June 19, 1861 in Cape Girardeau County, Missouri⁹. She died before 1865. He married **(3) Caroline Krueger** November 30, 1865 in Zion Lutheran Church, Gordonville, Missouri¹⁰. She was born 1841 in Hannover, Germany^{11,12,13}, and died November 18, 1881 in Cape Girardeau, Cape Girardeau County, Missouri¹⁴. He married **(4) Julia Koechig** April 27, 1883 in Cape Girardeau County, Missouri^{15,16}, daughter of **George Köchig** and **Johanna Hille**. She was born March 06, 1857 in Cape Girardeau County, Missouri^{17,18}, and died February 06, 1899 in Cape Girardeau, Cape Girardeau County, Missouri¹⁹.

Henry Amelunke married first to **Karolina von Lehle** on March 2, 1858 with the ceremony being performed by **Pastor E. Riedel**, Minister of the Lutheran Church. This is the same Caroline that is shown with Henry on the 1860 Cape Girardeau City census records and should not be confused with Henry's third wife **Karoline Krieger** whom he married in 1865.

There is a different Johann "Heinrich" Amelunke living in Gordonville, Missouri at the same time that Heinrich Andreas Amelunke is living in the City of Cape Girardeau. Both are confusing to differentiate and requires additional clarification. The Henry Amelunke - Karolina von Lehle marriage cannot be the Johann "Heinrich" Amelunke of Gordonville, MO as he has children by his first wife, Hanna Overfelt, ranging from 1856 through 1867 and

worked as a farmer. Heinrich Andreas Amelunke, however, immigrated to Cape Girardeau around 1850 when he was about 18 years old and worked as a Cooper.

Henry's second marriage occurred on June 19, 1861, to **Wilhelmine Woelkener** with the ceremony being performed by **Pastor E. Riedel**, Minister of the Lutheran Church. Again, Johann "Heinrich" Amelunke of Gordonville, is still married to Hanna Overfelt, so this is Heinrich Andreas Amelunke again.

Henry's third marriage was to **Karoline Krueger** on November 30, 1865 and his last marriage was to **Julia Koechig** on April 27, 1883, the former wife of **August Witzel** who died in 1947. Julia lived 8 years past Henry's death in 1891.

There is one marriage record unaccounted for on June 15, 1871, when Henry Amulunke married **Catherine Schmie**. Heinrich Andreas Amelunke was still married to Karoline Krieger as she did not die until November 1881. This falls into the time frame between when Johann Heinrich's last reported child by Hannah Overfelt of 1867 and his first child by Rosena Schweer in 1881 were born. I have found no clues to indicate that Heinrich Amelunke of Gordonville had a third wife however it would seem most likely.

Like his brother, Martin, Emil served in the military during World War I (Roll: 1983385, DraftBoard: 2) and returned to McLennan County, Texas after he was discharged.

Mrs. Mary W. Amelunke, 71 years old, wife of the late August Amelunke, died suddenly of a heart attack at 10 o'clock Monday night at the home of a son, Albert Amelunke at Dutchtown. She was sitting in a chair talking to friends when she was stricken.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon at Zion Lutheran Church with the pastor, Rev. G.B. Seboldt, in charge. Interment will be in the church cemetery. The body will remain at the Lorberg Funeral Home until noon Thursday.
