

WILL OF DAVID LONG Sr.

In the Name of God Amen I David Long^{Sr} of the County of Sussex and of the Delewar State Being weak of Body but of Sound mind & memory blefsted be God Do this Twenty fifth Day of April One thousand and Seven hundred & eighty five Make Publish and Declare this my Last will and Teftament in manner and form following that is to say, First my Desire is that all my lawfull Debts be paid and discharged by my Executer Also I give and bequeath to my Son David Long All that Tract or percel of Land where on he now Lives Called and known by the Name of Hubbey & Longs partnership To him his Heirs and assigns for Ever..._____

Also I Give and bequeath to my Son Benjamine Long Twenty Shillings in spacey to be Paid him by my Executer ----- Also I give and bequeath To my Son John Long part of a Tract or percil of Land Called Forrest Flower being the Weftermost land of said Tract and being the part where he the Said John Long now Liveth and to begin for the Division Line on the North Sid of Said Tract at a Ditch that Runs through Said Tract thence with Said Ditch souththerly as far as the above said Ditch Runs Straight throug the plantation and sou to continue with a straight Line Qutie a Cross the Tract as shall Run Parreral with the Straight Part of the above Defcribed Ditch To him His Heirs and afsigns for Ever -----

Also I Give and bequeath To my Son Armwell Long All the Remander part of the Above named Tract of Land Called Forrest Flower Being the Eaftermost Land from The Above Described Ditch and being the part where on I Now Liveth To him his Heirs and afsigns for Ever Also my will is that my Son Armwell Long & my wife Ann Long To have the use of my part of the Seader Swamp Called M^CCreas Pufsel The Profits arising from the occupying of the above Said Swamp to equalley Divide Btween the above Named Armwell Long and my Wife Ann Long Dureing her Natural Life and after hur the Said Ann Longs Deceas To be the full property of the above Named Armwell Long to him his heirs and afsigns for Ever also his Choyce of one Negro after my Deceas To him his heirs and afsigns for Ever ----

Also my will is that my wife Ann Long To have the use of all the Remander part of my Estate that is Not all Ready Willed and Given away Dureing her Natural Life and after her Decease to be Equally Divided between Nine of my children David Long John Long Armwell Long Mary Hutson Elezebeth Newport Nanney Scudder Rachel Holloway Myrom Gray & Joyce Chamberlen To Them there heirs and afsigns for Ever Last of all I Nominate and apoint my Son Armwell Long Executer of this my Last Will and Teftament and Revoking All former will or wills by me maid in witnefs hear of I have hear unto Sot my hand and Seal the Day and year above written.
