Nelsonville, O., "Grandma" Evans, aged 86, who has been ill for a number of weeks, died this morning about 1 o'clock of diseases incident to old age. The funeral will take place Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock from the residence of her son, William Evans in Happy Hollow. Rev. Cook of the Christian church will officiate and interment will be made at Green Lawn.

William Evans, aged seventy-four, died on Wednesday of last week of a complication of diseases incident to old age. Although in poor health for sometime he was not thought to be in a dangerous condition until a few days before his death. Funeral services at the family residence on Chestnut St., Saturday, were conducted by Rev. Martin, pastor of the Christian church. Interment at Green Lawn (sic.)

Nelsonville, June 2. Frank Evans, 79, died today after a three years illness from paralysis. He was born in England and came to his country when a small child with his parents. His wife has been dead 42 years. Two children also preceded him in death. One daughter Miss Hanna and two brothers, Will and Tom all of Nelsonville survive.

Funer services will be held from the brother's home, Will Evans, 201 Ashton Avenue Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock conducted by Rev. McCorkle.

Nelsonville man dies at home of his brother. George Evans, 65, succumbs. Had been invalid for life.
Nelsonville, Jan.1. George Evans, 65, died last night about 11 o'clock at the home of his brother,
William Evans, 201 Ashton Avenue. Since the age of fourteen, Mr. Evans has been an invalid, caused
by an accident while hunting. A shotgun carried by a companion was discharged, the bullet lodging in
Evans' brain.
He lived with his parents until their deaths. For the last fifteen years he has been cared for by his brother
and wife and his niece, Miss Hannah Evans, who ministered to him until his death.
Funeral services will be held at the residence Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock conducted by the Reb. O.
J. Howearth, pastor of the Christian church. Burial to be made at Greenlawn.

"STROKE IS FATAL TO SAM'L EVANS; Well Known South Side Resident Expires After Short Illness; Samuel Evans, age 61, died at 1:50 a.m. of paralysis. He had suffered a stroke 5 days earlier. He had been a resident of the city 20 years. Before that he was at Niles and Nelsonville, where he was born. He was first employed in the store room of Ohio Works. Was with Carnegie Steel the last 24 years. Born Oct. 22, 1862, he married Margaret Woods who died in Feb. 1905. He married Mrs. Margaret Webster May 7, 1919, who survives. Son, Ralph of Sheridan, Nebraska. Daughter, Mrs. C. B. Marsh. Four brothers, Frank, William, George and Thomas all of Nelsonville and 4 grandchildren.
