In 1840, moved to Pitts., South Side, where father died in 1849, age of 64 years, his widow in 1872, age 82. Joseph remain w/father till death and carried on

family farm until 1856 when he sold and bought present farm of 87 acres in Pen. In 1844 married Catharine Werling, born in Bavaria. (Her parent infor). M/M Ritter, lost 2 sons and 2 daughters in infancy and one son, John Nicholas, died at age of 20. Death again entered the RITTER home plucking from its midst Joseph, the second son of Catherine, and the late Sebastian RITTER, in his 33rd year. Joe, as he was familiarly known was sick but a very short time. He complained of not feeling well a few days ago and thinking he was not very ill reluctantly took his bed never to leave it again. Immediately typhoid fever in its worst form set in and notwithstanding the untiring efforts of the family and the physician Joe's vitality left him and he was unable to battle with its ravages, and on Wednesday morning died. The death of Mr. Joseph RITTER is exceptionally a sad one and to their many friends it seems as though the hand of fate has followed them with unusual destruction. Within the past four years death, through fever, has broken the family ties four times. Mrs. RITTER and family have the sympathy of their many friends in their bereavement.

In Witness Whereof, I, Mary Anne Bleichner the testatrix above named, have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal, the twentyeth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five. Mary Anne Bleichner"

"Jacob Bleichner, youngest son of Matthias and Catherine Bleichner, was born on the old homestead in Summit township, February 21, 1836, and received his education in the public schools. He was reared on the farm, and was engaged in mining coal for public work some five years, but farming has been his principal occupation throughout his life. He has owned the old homestead since 1864, and has resided upon it permanently since that time. On September 29, 1857 he married Mary Miller, a daughter of Joseph and Ann (Ritter) Miller, of Summit township. Eleven children have been born to this union, named as follows: Mary, wife of Headley Morris; Clara, wife of George Smith; Joseph; James; John; William; Elizabeth, wife of William Guest; Tillie; Louisa; Andrew, and Annie. Mr. Bleichner and family are members of St. Mary's Catholic church. Politically, he is a Democrat, has held every office in the gift of his township with the exception of justice of the peace, and has been a school director for twenty-one years. he is one of the substantial and progressive citizens of the community."
