History of Beaver County, Biographies West Side, p. 641:

Benjamin Dillworth came from Scotland to America at an early date. He was a farmer by occupation and settled in Westmoreland county, Pa. He married Mary McMinn, who bore him five sons and three daughters and as early as 1796 came to Beaver County where he purchased 400 acres of land and remained until his death.

History of Beaver County, v. 2, pg. 810, Darlington Borough: "Among the earliest settlers here were the Dilworths, the McMinns, the Martins, Sprotts, Boyds, Imbries, ...."

Genforum Message, Posted by Patricia Dureska, #137, Benjamin Dilworth Sr. came over from Scotland and had 2 wives. The first was Mary McMinn who has the sons John, who married Hanna Hunter on Oct. 20, 1773, Robert, Benjamin Jr., George b. @ 1765 in Lancaster Co., Pa but moved to Westmoreland Co., then Beaver Co., and married Margaret Keys, Joseph b. Mar 21, 1768 d. Aug 13, 1836 and Margaret. His second wife had Elizabeth, Jane who married a Wilson, Rachel who married a Green, Eleanor, Ann, and Hannah. This information was found in Abstract of Will on Sept. 11, 1793 for Westmoreland Co., Vol. 6, p. 31 (#123). They attended Mt. Pleasant Presbyterian Church in Westmoreland Co., Pa.

Joseph Dilworth b. 1812, a proven son of Joseph and Elizabeth was in Palmyra Twp. at the time of the 1840 Census. Although he was only 28 himself and recently married, a male 15-0 was listed with him on the Census.

From Virgil White's genal. Abstracts of Rev. War Pension Files: "Lambright, John, ... They had afterwards a child they called Elizabeth, born in the year 1789, who is now married to Joseph Dilworth as is reputed and resides in Portage County, Ohio is at present understood." (From a deposition filed March 1852.)

A Joseph Dilworth appears as an jail inmate in Portage County 1850 Census.

The marriage of Joseph Dilworth b. 1812 shows in Portage County Marriages Book 1. He married Catherine Edwards on 14 Sept 1837. The death certificate of a daughter of this marriage names her mother Catherine Evans, born in Wales.

1820 Joseph Dilworth, b. 1785 listed on census for Ravenna twp. next to John Musser b. 1796, married to Mary Lambright.

Joseph Dilworth b. 1812 had at least nine children and left many descendants in the Williams County area and up into Michigan. One of his daughters married back into the Lambright family. He at least had twin boys, b. abt. 1855 and the 1860 census shows three born that year. One hasn't been heard from since, but they could have been triplets.
