Warren Daily Tribune, April 14, 1903 - Front page:

"HENRY MARSH DROWNED. Wandered into the river near Miller & Neal's Flour Mill. Body was found by Thomas Kagy. Early This Morning - Left Home Last Night to do an Errand - was 76 years old and was born in England - Leaves Family.

Henry Marsh of No. 10 River Place was drowned in the river at Miller & Neal's flour mill Monday night.

The body was discovered at about 6 o'clock Tuesday morning by Thomas Kagy, an employe of the mill. Mr. Kagy was going to work and when passing along the bank beside the mill race noticed on the bank a pair of shoes and in between the race and the bank another pair of shoes and a part of a coat protruding out of the water. Investigating further Mr. Kagy pulled the remains out on the bank and notified Marshal Griffin.

Marshal Griffin notified Coroner Hoover. After the coroner had viewed the remains they were taken to Cross' morgue where they were identified by Fred Waye, and his son Henry who works at the Trumbull Manufacturing Company, was notified.

The place where the body was found is only about four feet wide and when the river is normal, is dry, but the present high

water has made it about three feet deep.

The last seen of Mr. Marsh at home was about 5:30 Monday afternoon, when he left his home to go on an errand to the home of Miss Howard on East Market street.

When he did not return late last night his son called at the Howard home and was informed that Mr. Marsh had left there about 6:30. The last seen of him by any one else was about 7:30, when the watchman at the main street crossing saw him pass his shanty. It was raining very hard at that time and it is supposed that the old man became bewildered and wandered down near the mill where he accidentally fell into the water.

Mr. Marsh was 76 years old. He was born in Dorchester, England, and has lived here for about ten years. For some time past he has been working around the Austin house, taking care of it for the owner, W. W. Dunnivant. He was a faithful member of Christ Episcopal church here and communed there last Sunday.

Mr. Marsh is survived by his wife and four sons, Richard and Henry of this city and Charles and Samuel of Niles. The funeral will be held at the Episcopal church probably Thursday."

The funeral of Charles Marsh, who was drowned Monday night will be held tomorrow afternoon at 1:30 at the Episcopal Church.

"Mrs. Emma May Marsh, wife of Richard J. Marsh, a well known and highly regarded resident of the city, passed away at the family residence at 1017 E. South st., Friday evening at 6:30, death being due to an attack of flu followed by heart complications. Mrs. Marsh had been ill for four weeks, and had spent two weeks at the hospital and her family were of the opinion that she was rallying from her illness. A sudden attack of heart trouble came as a shock to them and announcement of her death is received with keen regret.

Mrs. Marsh was 56 years old and had spent her early life in Niles. Twenty-five years ago the family came to Warren and have resided here since that time. She was a devoted member of the Central Christian church, and a woman of fine christian influence in her home and community. She is survived by her husband, a son, Nelson E. Marsh, at home; a brother, Ulysses Grant Campbell, DeForest; and a sister, Mrs. Emma Flaming, Jackson, Mich. Funeral services will be held Monday at 2 o'clock at the home on South st., when Rev. C. M. Oliphant will officiate. Burial will be made in Oakwood cemetery."

27 March, 1923, 14:4:

"Funeral services over the remains of the late Mrs. Emma May marsh, wife of Richard Marsh, who passed away on Friday evening, were held on Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the family residence at 1017 East South st.

Many relatives and friends of the deceased joined in the services, which were in charge of Rev. C.M. Oliphant, assisted by Rev. H.C. Burkhart. Selections were sung by Mrs. L.J. Cook and lovely floral emblems were placed on the casket.

The pall bearers were E. Fleming, James Smithers, R.M. Skillman, Charles and James marsh and Fred Seagreaves. The body was laid to rest in Oakwood cemetery."
