Also: On two warrants dated 14 November 1743 and 4 May 1750, Benjamin dilworth had surveyed 113 3/4 acres to which he added 36 acres of Alexander Ross' warrant of 4 November 1714..."Dilworth was a useful man in his day, furnishing means to those who needed and of course, helping himself at the same time." On assessment rolls for Little Britain in 1763 and 1769.

Genforum Message, Posted by Patricia Dureska, #137, Benjamin Dilworth Sr. came over from Scotland and had 2 wives. The

first was Mary McMinn who has the sons John, who married Hanna Hunter on Oct. 20, 1773, Robert, Benjamin Jr., George b. @ 1765 in Lancaster Co., Pa but moved to Westmoreland Co., then Beaver Co., and married Margaret Keys, Joseph b. Mar 21, 1768 d. Aug 13, 1836 and Margaret. His second wife had Elizabeth, Jane who married a Wilson, Rachel who married a Green, Eleanor, Ann, and Hannah. This information was found in Abstract of Will on Sept. 11, 1793 for Westmoreland Co., Vol. 6, p. 31 (#123). They attended Mt. Pleasant Presbyterian Church in Westmoreland Co., Pa.

p. 11: 6 Nov 1806, mortgage. Benjamin Dilworth of CCO to George McKean, Beaver Co., PA., indebted for \$1,000, now for 1 shilling to Dillworth, mortgage to McKean tract on which Dilworth lives in CCO, 339 acres in 1-8-2, Ptd. to Dilworth in 1805 as security on payment. Signed Beaver Co., PA

21 June 1806, Benjamin Dilworth and Nancy, his wife, of CCO, to George Kate of CCO for \$250, 100 acres in 1-8-2, originally patented to Dilworth.

24 Oct 1806, sum of money owed by Benjamin Dilworth to George McKain ass.d mortgage on 14 Nov. 1806 land of 339 acres 1-8-2, now McKean for \$2000 pd by Dilworth or leases.

Of these sons George was reared in Westmoreland county, and as early as 1796 came to Beaver county, where he purchased 400 acres of land, and remained until his death. His wife, Margaret (Kees) of Irish descent and who died in October, 1839, aged seventy-four, bore him eight children, of whom James was the youngest. George Dillworth died in 1840, aged seventy-five years. James P. was born and reared on the farm where he always lived. He now owns 800 acres, part of the original tract.

In 1850 was in Williams Co. This Joseph had at least nine children and left many descendants in the Williams Co., area.
