1. Richard¹ Bundock was born 1634, and died 1665. He married **Ruth**. She was born 1636, and died Bef. 10 Feb 1683/84.

p. 524: Richard Bundick (Bundock) rec'd 1400 acs. in Accomack Co., 12 July 1664 (p.400, 460) for transport of 28 persons. (Same in Va. Court Recrods, Vol. VI, p. 460)

p. 296 Rich. Bundoch, 650 acs. Northampton Co., 21 Nove. 1654, p. 294, transport of 14 persons.

Some Records of Sussex County:

p. 62 - An action of Debt. Richard Bundock plt. William Davids deft; withdrawn by order of the plt and deft.

p. 63 - An Action of the case - Richard Bundock plt, Corneliss Johnson, deft; [with drawn]

p. 93 - Richard Bundock assigned over in open Court to Norton Claypoole and his assigns one man servant by name of Matthew Osborne for 3 years from the 7th day of this month, that Norton Claypoole save his land or sell to Matthew's satisfaction, and that Matthew be allowed to seat the land during time of service. To serve till they are 24 by Virginia law.

p. 133 - Richard Bundock receives 1/2 of Richard Shoulter's prop. Will January 28, 1682

p. 134, Cornelius Verhoofe, sick at Richard Bundock's home makes will. Richard Bundock receives bequest.

p. 103. Will/Bequest all estate to Rich'd Bundick

p. 118 Ruith Bundick, Thomas Jones' Mother petitioned (June 1687)

2. Grace/Gratioser² Bundock (Richard¹) was born Abt. 1660 in King's Co., NY. She married **Aert Jansz Verkerk** 28 Jul 1681 in Sussex Co. Del. USA, son of Jan Verkerck and Marijke/Mayke Gijsberts/Gisberts. He was born Abt. 1655 in

Buren, GELD, NLD, and died in Sussex County, Delaware.

Teunes G. Bergen, Register of the Early Settlers of King's County, pg. 369, Verkerk or Verkerken, Aerd or Aert Janse, of N.U., b. 1655; m. Gratioser (???). In 1695 he resided in Lewis Co. on the South River or Delaware. His descendants are to be found in E. N. J. Issue: -- Jan of N.J., bp. Nov. 12, 1682, at N. U.; (sup.) Mayke, m. Jan Lambertse of N.J.; (sup.) Hendrick of N. J.; Gerrit of N. J.; and Syke or Sytie, m. Johannes Truwexs. made his mark 'A' to documents."

New Jersey Family Histories #1, 1600s-1800s, Genealogies of New Jersey Families, Volume 1, pages 961-975, Children Mayke (supposed) and Setyje added to list. Left New Utrecht between Nov. 1682 and July 12, 1683 when he appeared as plaintiff in a Sussex Co. Delaware court (Records of Sussec Co. Delaware, p. 55). Witnessed as will there: May, 1688, Dec. 29, 1687 - signed "A". Jan. 3, 1690; he and Grace both signed affidavit there; Nov. 28, 1690. Married there by records of Sussex Co. on July 17, 1681 but back in NU for baptism of son Jan.

Genealogies of Long Island Families:

Left New Utrecht between Nov. 1682 when first recorded child baptised and July 12, 1683 when appeared as Plaintiff in a Sussex Co., Delaware Court (Recs. of Sussex Co. Delaware p. 55)

Witnessed a will there May, 1688; Dec. 29, 1687 signed "A"; Jan. 3, 1690, Art, and Art and Grace both signed affidavit there on Nov. 28, 1690. Married there by records of Sussex Co. on July 17, 1681, but back in New Utrecht for baptism of son Jan.

The will of Henrick Asueress [Asuerus, Asuersee] made Nov. 1694, Sussex, Cty, Delaware, probated 04 Feb 1701 names Art Johnson Vankirk sole heir. No exec'r; wits: John Manlove, Jr., Henry Moliston; will book Arch. vol A57; Reg. of Wills, Liber A; pg. 196; folios 18-19

Genealogies:

Art first mentioned in 1710 when Art Virkirk, yeoman, deed land to his son Art Verkirk. In 1729 Art Verkerk "Senir" and "Juner" jointly deeded land to another. Father signed "A" and son full name. (This was common apparently) Also "yeoman". Made will Nov. 20, 1742. Ann presented account as exec. to Sussex Co. Orphan's Court Feb. 28, 1744.
