Godspeed's History of Franklin, Jefferson, Washington, Crawford and Gasconade Counties, Missouri, 1888, Crawford Co. has three railroads: 1: The St. Louis and San Francisco; 2: The St. Louis, Salem & Little Rock Railroad; and 3: The Cherry Valley Railroad. No. 2's founder was A. L. Crawford of New Castle, Penn (with backing by folks in Pitts). Construction began in the Spring of 1872 and was complete by July 1873. It was taken over by #1 in 1887. RR3 was built in 1877.

Fannie married Henry Bevins (by census) after 1887 and before 1894 (when she signed for daughters to be married still Fannie Lynn in 1887; Fannie Bevins in 1894 Can find no reference to this marriage in Pittsburgh.

Sued to recover monies spent on doctors for granddaughter after settlement of \$2,000 given to Hilda. Sued because of threat of losing home and properties for non-payment. Lived at 5128 Carnegie Avenue, Pittsburg via court documents.

Hilda Michener's request for monies in June, 1901 says mother had "moved from vicinity" and they could no longer live with them (Note that Hilda Married William Cupps in May, 1901)

Harry Meisinger, an engineer at Clark's Solar iron works, was hit by the end of a broken belt this morning and probably fatally hurt. Meisinger resides on Forty-sixth street and was married about a year ago.

HURLED AGAINST A WALL: Young Man Badly Injured by the Breaking of a Belt

Harry Meisinger was probably fatally injured at 8:30 a.m. at the Solar Iron works, where he was employed as a stationary engineer. He was standing near a heavy belt, which was in motion, when it broke and struck him. He was hurled several feet against a brick wall and was badly hurt. He was terribly bruised about the head and body, and is suffering from concussion of the brain.

Meisinger was rendered senseless and had not recovered consciousness at 1 o'clock. He is a young man and was married only a short time ago. His home is on Forty-sixth st.

Fatally Injured by a Belt: Harry Meisinger of Forty-sixth street will likely die from injuries received yesterday at the Solar iron works, Lawrenceville. He was struck by a belt breaking and hurled against a wall. He has since been unconscious at the West Penn Hospital.
