11. Mrs. Ida Coleman obituary, *Urbana Daily Citizen*, Urbana, Champaign, Ohio, 20 April 1943, Mrs. Ida C. Coleman, 82, widow of James Coleman, died at 11 p.m. Monday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Harley Shaffer, four miles north of Urbana.

Mrs. Coleman had been an invalid for the past two and one-half years and bedfast for the last 10 weeks. She was born December 11, 1860, in Concord Township.

In addition to Mrs. Shaffer is another daughter, Mrs. Mary Miller, Columbus; three sons, J. P. Coleman, West Liberty; W. S. Coleman, Iowa, and Claude Coleman, Urbana; two brothers, S. W. Bruner, Dialton, and Claude Bruner, Flushing, Ohio; three sisters, Mrs. S.E. Lipse, Springfield, Mrs. L. K. Botkin, North Hampton, and Mrs. J. L. Abbott, Cleveland. Twenty-eight grandchildren and 34 great-grandchildren also survive.

The body will remain at the residence until time for service at 2 p.m. on Thursday in the Concorn Methodist Church. Interment is to be made in Concor Cemetery by Judd W. Wilkins funeral service of West Liberty.

Funeral services for Mrs. Ida C. Coleman were held on Thursday at 2 p.m. at the Concord Church with Rev. Robert Lawrence officiating and was assisted by Rev. J. Paul Clark. Interment was made in the Concord Cemetery.

Two hymns were impressively sung by the Concord Church male quartet, composed of Messrs. Earl Michael, Chester Hesselgesser, Claude Neal and Oliver Loffer. The beautiful floral pieces were arranged by eight grand daughters, Mildred Cole, Lillian Simpson, Ida Bishop, Dorothy Lockwood, Betty Dannaker, Doris Shaffer, Avis and Betty Coleman. Pall bearers serving were grandsons Robert, Russel and Harold Shaffer, Gilbert, Ralph and Robert Coleman.
