North Lewisburg -- Franklin P. Coleman, 71, of Rt 3, Arcadia, Florida and formerly of Middleburg, died Friday, March 17 at 8:20 a.m. in Fawcett Hospital, in Port Charlotte, Florida.

He was born April 4, 1917 in Champaign County, a son of John P. and Myrtle Ward Coleman. He was married to Beverly Smith.

A retired school bus driver for Benjamin-Logan Schools, he ha served as a chief petty officer in the U. S. Coast Guard during the Korean War and World War II.

He was a member of VFW Post 1080 in Bellefontaine, and of American Legion Post 110 and Moose Lodge 2121 in Port Charlotte, Florida.

Survivors include his wife; a son, Ronald P. Coleman of East Liberty; and a daughter, Mrs. James (Tamara) VanNess of Bellefontaine. By a former marriage to Stella Inskeep, he is survived by five grandchildren, three step-grandchildren and three great-grandsons. Other survivors are two stepdaughters, Peggy Zupp of Rushsylvania and Karen Tucker of Ft. Myers, Florida; a stepson, David Fairchild of Bellefontaine; two sisters, Mildred Cole of Arcadia, Florida, and Ida Mae Bishop of Sarasota, Florida; and a brother Sylvan Coleman of Port Charlotte.

Memorial services will be held Saturday at 2 p.m. in the Freshwater-McDonald Funeral Home, North Lewisburg, with the Rev. Fred Clogg officiating. Burial and military graveside services will follow in Mt. Tabor Cemetery, West Liberty. There will be no calling hours.
