

**De Aston “Big School “ roof timbers of 1863**



This is the east end of the roof space above the old “Big School” The bell rope can still be seen in the corner of the picture.



This is the western end of the “Big School”. The three pane window is the only “en situ” part of Headmaster Temperley’s memorial window – the rest of which is presently in the School dining room. This window, once on the outside of the building, now looks blindly into dormitories built in the 1904 extensions to the school.

The graffiti, now lost, was regularly scratched by boarders. Visible is a reference to Mr Peter Hartmann, who died in the Boarding House in 1992.
