Hugh Evans, although past 65, accompanied a surveying party into what is now Highland Co. They explored several tracts of land but decided to locate their land grant on Clear Creek, northeast of the present site of the county seat. Nathaniel Massie entered several tracts in the Evans name since he was in the party. The surveys he entered for them were: Hugh and Amos Evans, Survey No. 2, 414-600 acres, dated Mar. 18, 1797; Daniel Evans, Survey No. 2, 415 - 400 acres, same date; and Samuel Evans Survey, No. 2, 416-400 acres, dated Mar. 19, 1797. Other surveys were entered until the total acreage was over 3,000.

In the spring of 1799, Hugh Evans, his sons, Richard, Samuel and Daniel, his sons-in-law, William Billy Hill, husband of Sallie Evans, daughter by his first marriage, and Joseph Swearingen, left their Kentucky home to prepare their land for their families. They followed the trace cut through from Maysville to New market and after a short visit with the genial Oliver Ross, cut a road through to their land grant on Clear Creek. They set about clearing land, built a cabin and planted some seeds to provide food to take care of their needs. The wild game provided their meat supply for the summer.
