The Hendryx and Bronson families came to Wakeman together in 1819. We do not know where the Bronson family lived, but Bronson bought the C. C. Canfield place. He died in August 1820, aged thirty years. His widow married Asahel Buck. The son, Ebenezer Warner, sold the place to Mr. Canfield. Mrs. Bronson's mother, Mrs. Jedidah Hendryx, lived with them, and died June 14, 1820, at the age of 67. <p>The History of Wakeman Township, Pages 121 through 130 HENDRYZ, Barzilla S. – (the name sometimes spelled "Hendricks") came to Wakeman with his wife and an adopted son in June 1819. He bought the whole of Lot 14 from Burton Canfield in 1824, at least the deed was dated Jan. 27, 1824, and was made out to S. B. Hendryx. In 1827, he received a deed to 115 acres of Lot 57 (east part of the Cahoon farm) in the name of Squire B. Hendryx. It is likely that his name was Barzilla Squire Hendryx, and that he was called Squire at his old home, hence the error in the deed. He sold part of Lot 14 to Woodward Todd and Sheldon Smith, but lived where Sumner Todd now lives. His wife was Sally Hill and she died Jan. 1, 1828, at the age of 46. Horace, the adopted son died in 1827, at the age of sixteen. Mr. Hendryx married 2nd, Maria Phillips on Aug. 2, 1828. On the 4th of February 1830, Mr. Hendryx was thrown from a sleigh near Merritt Hyde's and received injuries which caused his death the next day. The widow married 2nd, Daniel Shelton, of Vermillion in 1835 and they moved to Flint, Michigan, in 1849, and she died at the home of her son in her 77th year. Mrs. Jedidah Hendryx, the mother of Barzilla and of the wife of Abraham Bronson, came here with the family and died June 14, 1820, being the first one of the settlers to die.</p>		<p>Next came Samuel Bristol, who left Connecticut on May 28th and reached Vermillion on July 4th. The wife and son remained there with French until Mr. Bristol could erect a log house for a home. Erastus French, a single man, came in the fall of 1817. In May, 1818, came Dr. Clark and wife. In 1819 came B. S. Hendryx and Abraham Bronson, and later in that year, Sheldon Smith. In 1820 came Silas French and Burton French. In 1821 came Chester Manvel. In 1822 came Justin and Philo Sherman, Leverett Hill and James Wilson. In 1823 came Merritt Hyde and Amos Clark. In 1824, Russell Barnes, in 1826 Sheldon Barnes, in 1827 Rufus Bunce, Isaac and Kneeland Todd. Justin Sherman kept a record of the inhabitants until 1827. <p>The only possible clue I might have is from the Jackson Family genealogy, which states that Ruth Hendryx Biddlecombe and Lois Hendryx Dunham (sisters) MAY have had a sister Susan (?Susanna?) who married a Hawkins. My Isaiah Hendryx was a brother to them, so Susan would have been born possibly ca. 1760's-1780's. This family was apparently born in or was from Redding Ct; have not found anything there re: church records, but they may not have been members of the Congregational Church, but another denomination. There were Hendryx people in Redding and nearby, but records are sparse and nothing that fits with either mine or your Hawkins Hendryx. There is a Hawkins Hendrick in the 1820 Geauga County Ohio census. My Hendryx ended up in Bennington, VT about 1800. It's possible this "Susan" married a Hawkins there. In the fall of 1835 his father left his home in Ohio and came west to Muscatine county, Iowa, where he remained a short time; when with a sack of corn meal on his shoulders he started out for Linn county, Iowa. Crossing Cedar river, he erected a log cabin on the site of the present city of Cedar Rapids, being the second building erected in the town. Here he remained through the winter, subsisting on the corn meal and wild honey he found in the timber. Here he made a claim where the beautiful city of Cedar Rapids now stands, which he afterwards traded for a balky mare and an old set of harness, the whole value not being more than \$25. He then returned to his home in Ohio on a visit, where he remained a short time, and again came to Linn county and located in Grant township, where he erected the first cabin in that township. The Hemphill's came to Linn county in 1844, and located in Otter Creek township. Caleb Hendryx and Mary Hemphill were married in 1845. In 1846 Mr. Hendryx traded for a farm in Otter Creek township, where he remained until his death, which occurred in February, 1876. Mr. Hendryx [sic, Mrs. ?] is living on the old homestead, which has never changed hands since the patent was issued. H. H. Hendryx, the subject of this memoir, was married in 1871 to Miss Elizabeth Arnett, a daughter of Andrew Arnett, of Ohio. She was born in Cedar county, Iowa, February 15, 1846. Two children blessed this union -- Martin B. and Ethel M. Mr. Hendryx is a member of Industry Lodge I.O.O.F.; also of the A.O.U.W.
