George Waltz

Naturalization

Do the Honorable the Court of Common Pleas of
Camden County in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
County Humbly Sheweth That your petitioner is
a native of the Province of Wissemburg in France
and was heretofore a subject of the Emperor of France and that he
has resided within the limits and under the jurisdiction of the Uni-
ted States of America for five years and within the State of Penn-
sylvania one year and that two years prior to this application
that is to say on sixth day of December A.D. 1852 at a Court of
Commons of this County your petitioner declared his intention of
becoming a citizen of the United States in the manner required by
law as in and by Naturalization Docters 2044 Page 134 appears;
that he will support the Constitution of the United States, and that
he doth absolutely and entirely renounce and forever abjure all
allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, and sov-
erignty whatever, and, particularly to the Emperor of France of
whom he was heretofore a subject Your petitioner therefore prays that
he may be admitted to become a citizen of the United States of A-
merica

I George Waltz do swear that the facts set forth in this my peti-
tion are true and that I will support the Constitution of the Uni-
ted States, and that I do absolutely and entirely renounce and fore-
ever abjure all allegiance fidelity to any foreign prince potentate
and sovereignty whatever and particularly, do absolutely and entirely
renounce and abjure forever all allegiance and fidelity to the Em-
peror of France whereof I was heretofore a subject,
