

Know All Men by these Presents,

That we, Elizabeth Walz and

both of the County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania, are held and firmly bound to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the sum of Six hundred dollars, lawful money to be paid to the said Commonwealth, her certain attorney or assignee to which payment was and truly to be made and done, we do bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators, and each of us, severally by these presents: sealed with our seals, and dated the 10th day of June A. D. 1864

The condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bounden Elizabeth Walz guardian of Elizabeth, George & Edward minor children of John Walz late of the county aforesaid, deceased, shall at least once in every three years, and at any other time when required by the Orphans' Court for the County of Cambria, render a just and true account of the management of the property and estate of said minor, under her care, and shall also deliver up said property agreeably to the order and decree of said court, or the directions of law, and shall in all respects faithfully perform the duties of guardian of the said Minor then the said obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
