There is inclosed your Adjusted Service Certificate, issued pursuant to the World War Adjusted Compensation Act, based upon the amount of your Adjusted Service Credit, as certified to this Bureau by the Department under which you last served while in the Military or Naval forces of the United States.

While the World War Adjusted Compensation Act as amended provides for the issuance of a duplicate certificate in the event that the original is lost or destroyed, it also requires that an indemnity bond be furnished in a penal sum of the face value of such lost or destroyed certificate before such duplicate can be issued. Therefore, care should be taken to prevent the loss or destruction of the certificate.
