ST. MARY ROMAN CATHOLIC CEMETERY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that St. Mary Roman Catholic Cemetery, for and in consideration of Four Hundred DOLLARS unto it paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant to

the right of burial, subject to the Rules and Regulations of said Cemetery, in

THAT CERTAIN BURIAL PLOT situate in St. Mary Roman Catholic Cemetery in Ross Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, described as Section III, Lot No. 744A, Number of Graves 3, as marked in the Plan of said Cemetery, which Plan and a copy of said Rules and Regulations are kept in the Office of said Cemetery and in the office of St. Mary Roman Catholic Church,

UNDER AND SUBJECT, however to the following conditions and restrictions:

FIRST: Any burial pursuant to the right granted herein must be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Roman Catholic Church governing Catholic Burial, as determined by the Bishop of Pittsburgh and the Rules and Regulations of this Cemetery.

SECOND: No monument, marker, stone or other structure may be erected, nor may any tree, shrub, hedge, plant or flowers be placed or planted on the burial plot unless the same be expressly permitted by the Rules and Regulations of this Cemetery and all such monuments, markers, stones, other structures, trees, shrubs, hedges, plants and flowers shall remain subject at all times to any and all Rules and Regulations of this Cemetery now or hereafter adopted.

THIRD: The Grantee may give this right of burial in his will to his spouse or, subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Cemetery, to one or more of his blood relatives (subject, however, until remarriage, to a vested right of burial in the surviving spouse of the Grantee). If the Grantee's will does not cover this burial right, the right shall descend, subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Cemetery to the Grantee's heirs at law, (subject, however, until remarriage, to a vested right of burial in the surviving spouse of the Grantee). The spouses of said heirs at law shall have the right of burial, subject, however, to the approval of all the remaining adult heirs at law. The right of burial shall be in said heirs at law in the order of their deaths.

FOURTH: The burial rights granted herein may not be assigned to any person other than to St. Mary Roman Catholic Church and will terminate should there be no burial in said plot within a period of one hundred years following the last burial therein. Upon such termination, the Cemetery has the right to take possession of said plot either for development of the Cemetery or resale to other persons.
