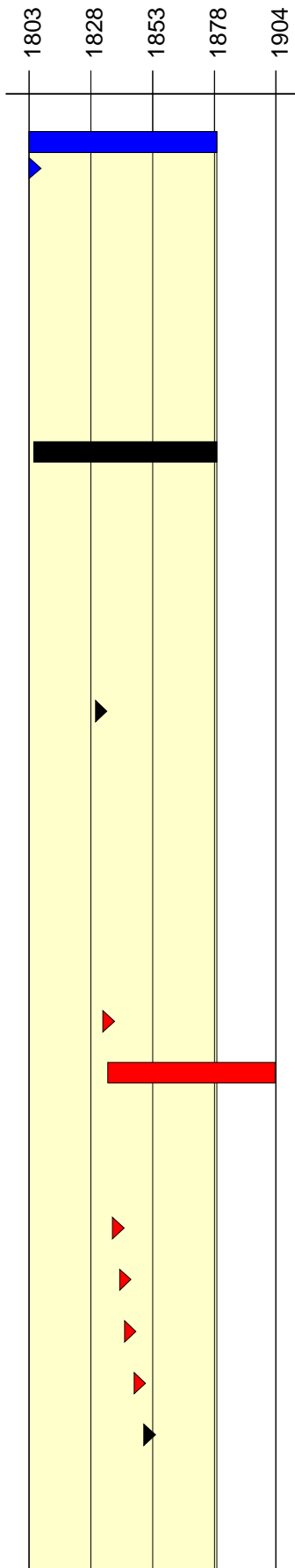

USA, Tennessee. Larkin's birth year is estimated here based on his being reported as 47 in the 1850 census and 66 in the one for 1870. Interestingly, in 1850, he is reported to be three years younger than Elizabeth (reported to be 50); but in 1870, he is shown to be six years older!

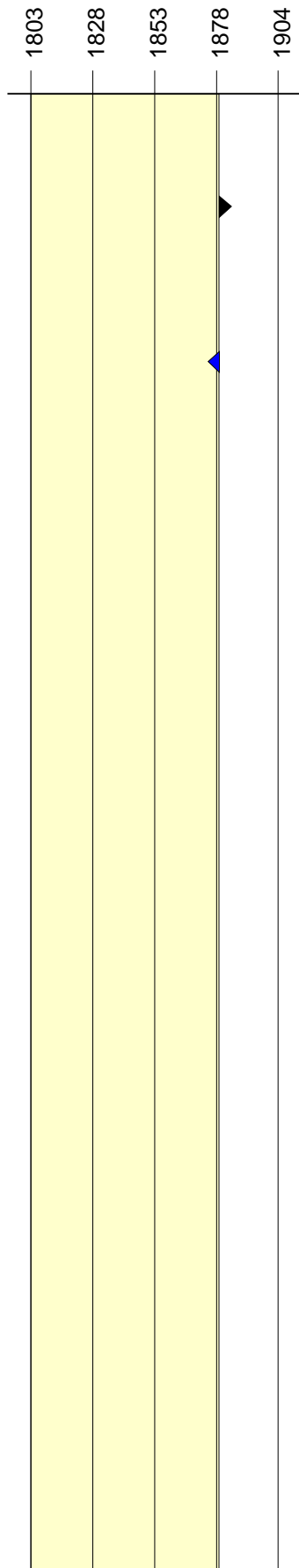
