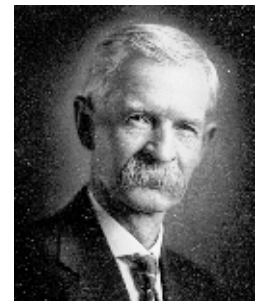

I am really concerned that we are not getting enough reader input into this newsletter [all issues are archived for future generations]. Each of you have Hawkins “stories,” pictures, etc. that have been passed down to you. Share them with us, and let’s run them in our Family Groups section each month. As an example I offer the following [from my book, *HAWKINS.....A Migrating American Family 1861 - 2001*].

“Jonas [Hawkins - my great grandfather] was a man of integrity, and had inherited, probably from his Quaker roots, a strong sense of moral responsibility. In 1924, while serving as president of the First National Bank of Tipton [IN], there was a depression and the bank failed. Jonas felt that he had not properly supervised the loan officer, who had made a number of bad loans. There was no legal liability upon the three stockholders, but when the other two did not join in restitution, Jonas took it upon himself to ensure that no depositor lost any money. He mortgaged his land and personally repaid the depositors 100% on the dollar. Later, in the 1930s when he divided the land among the children, it still carried a mortgage that was not retired until the 1940s.”



In my Family Group-04 presentation, starting on page 3, I present my data on Isaac, the son of James and Martha (Hollowell) Hawkins.

We spend a lot of time looking for our ancestors. Wouldn't it be nice if they just showed up in our email's inbox? With the free tool, **Google Alerts**, this is possible.

By creating a Google Alert, whenever Google finds your word or phrase that you are interested in, Google will automatically send you an email. For example, I am searching for an ancestor, James Marion McCall. If, today, I don't find anything relevant, I can create a Google Alert for his name, and then work on other things, such as get ready for our [7th annual Legacy Genealogy Cruise to Australia and New Zealand](#). :)

Then, if someone publishes new information to a website that Google finds, I'll get an email with a direct link to the new page.

Here's how to do it.

- 1) Go to www.google.com/alerts, enter your search terms, your email address, and click "Create Alert".
- 2) Google then sends you a verification email. You will not receive Google Alerts on your topic until you click the link in the verification email to confirm your request.

While you are enjoying life, Google is working for you. When it finds your phrase, you will receive an email with a link to the website, and hopefully information about your ancestor.

Technology Tip of the Month--Photo Restoration with Adobe Photoshop, Version 9.02: The Nitty Gritty III, Layers by Kay Spears.

Now that you're familiar with the basics of cloning [see my November Hawkins newsletter], we will move on to Layers. Why use layers when restoring photographs? Layers allow you to work on one element of an image without disturbing the others. Changes made using layers, such as color touch-ups, are easily reversible without going through a large number of steps – just drag the layer with the undesirable changes to the trash can! To work with layers, you need to open the Layers palette. Go to Menu > Window > Layers.

The Layers palette has a thumbnail image of your photograph, which may be turned off. However, you may find that retaining the thumbnail helps you track which layer you are altering. There is also an eye icon next to each layer. Clicking on the eye allows you to make that layer either visible or invisible. You may add as many layers as you want, and arrange them in any order by clicking and dragging. Make sure you keep track of the layer that is "active." To add a new layer, click on the icon that looks like a sheet of paper with a folded corner, located on the lower right of the Layers palette, right next to the convenient trash can icon.

When you open up your photograph in Adobe, notice that it is identified as the background layer. The background layer is always the bottommost image in your Layers palette. If you want to move the background layer to the top, it needs to be converted to a regular layer by either double clicking on it or right clicking and choosing > Layer from Background > New, and clicking ok. Now that layer can be

moved through the stack of other layers on the palette.

Another excellent use of layers is with photographs that have come apart. The pieces can be put back together just like a jigsaw puzzle by using the Layers palette. First, arrange all the pieces together on the glass of the scanner and scan as one image. Scanning the pieces separately creates variable images that are hard to put together again. The Magic Wand, the Lasso tool or the Erase tool can each be used to reassemble the photograph. Choose whichever is easiest for you to use. In all cases, you will want each piece of the photo to be on its own layer. If you use the Magic Wand tool, select a piece. Then right click and choose > Layer via copy. This creates a new layer with just that one piece on it. Repeat this process for all of the pieces. When you use the Lasso tool, use the “mouse” to draw freehand around the piece and then repeat the same steps used for the Magic Wand. If you use the Erase tool, duplicate the image once for each piece by right clicking on the layer and choosing > Duplicate layer. Then just erase all but one piece on each layer, keeping a different piece of the photograph on each separate layer.

Whichever method you use, you will end up with a separate layer for each piece. Then move each piece into place by using the arrow keys on your keyboard. When they’re in place, you will want to merge all the pieces together by right clicking on the topmost layer and choosing > Merge down. Repeat this process. Once they are all on one layer, you probably will need to do some crack repairs by using the Clone tool. Then you will have a perfectly seamless image.

Isaac, the son of James and Martha (Hollowell) Hawkins.

"John & Isaac, s James & Martha, gets 30-5-1767 to Bush River MM, S.C.: John's Cert was withheld by his own con that he had paid the Sheriff Militia fines;" (Hinshaw, Vol VI, p.504, Fairfax, VA MM.)

He [Isaac] married in VA "out of unity" Margaret Kenworthy, and was "disowned" in July 1767. (Per *The Families Hawkins, Mills, Confer, & Gillett With Related Lines*, by Patricia Confer Spencer in 1975)

"Isaac Hawkins who was gct Bush River MM, S.C. in 5 mo last rpd mou; Friends to "take in" the cert of removal & due to the distance leave him to that Mtg to be dealt with 25-7-1767 (Note: He stands dis by Fairfax MM) (See Hinshaw V-1,pp 1020-1031)" (Hinshaw, Vol VI, p.504, Fairfax, VA MM.)

A tax receipt from 1807 shows taxes paid by Isaac for himself and his brothers on well in excess of 4000 "acors of land of last quality" on Cane Creek, Tyger River and Tinker Creek. South Carolina Union the 28 of the 8 month 1814

*Loving brother and sister Benjamin and Olive Hawkins and your childred I am glad of this opportunity of wrighting to you to infor you how we are at this time (.) I am trouble with a disorder so ** I am troubled much at this time so that I can hardly sight to wright (.) I received they letter which was grate satisfaction to hear from you all and from brother John for I did not eexpect to that he was alive for I have not heard from him this long time(.) Thee has wright to me about they money I have got all they money that I expect to git tel I sel more of they land- I have not got nothing from the wido hollingsworth- I have gat they money from James Davis I got nine hundred and niteen dollars but I cannot git any chanc of sending it yoet Thee Wright me to send it by Johathan Roberts or Jonathan Cook I intend to send thee seventy dollars by*

Jonathan Cook and thee may send for the rest as soon as thee can thee has writ to me about the mil affairs with William Rise I think that it settled for I paid him for his troubel so conclud they

LETTER FROM ISAAC HAWKINS TO BENJAMIN HAWKINS

"South Carolina Union District the 16 day of the first month 1815(.) Loving Brother and Sister. Benjamin Hawkins and Olive Hawkins and your children(.) I gladly embrace this oppertunity to infour you how we are at this time(.) I expect the medison that 1 have been taiking that Caleb Fraser has given me has heltp me and will help me against the Spring to the rest of my childern are midling well for ought I know thee has wroght to me to send out what money 1 have got for thee from James Davis for rent(.) I received the first payment 130 dollars and then thee received 20 dollars and the bridg being taken away by the water that was alowed to be 190 dollars to be taken from thee first--pree and 1 revived 919 dollars from David Johnson for Jame Davis(.) I received 20 dollars from William Wilson and 15 dollars from William Hollingsworth and 12 dollars from John Brown for the rent of that land at the nil all this money is from the estate of John Cook--the land thee give in for me to pay for was 831 acors and the tax was about seventy sent a year the whole land lalist year it was double what it was before--thee may inform Cousin Amos Hawkins wrote me me abought his fathers land thee my tell him I have not sold the land but I will sell it as soon as I can-- theiris one dollar and 12 1/2 cen of this money that I have taken to pay John Ashby for carring thee chain of they land which thee ought to slow in the deision of this money thee wrote to me about that money I pad to Richard Cox for thee and Brother Amos 1 paid it of thye money and he must pay thee two dollars and 50 cent that will make it right---thee has wrote to me for to send thy money(.) I have sent thee five hunderd and eight three dollars 88 cent by Jesse Green [husband of Charity Cook step-dau. of Benjamin

Book 0, pages 77.78: South Carolina, Union District. Whereas Isaac Hawkins died seized of a tract of 107 acres on waters of Cane Creek and Whites Branch, leaving us, John Hawkins, Benjamin Hawkins, Amos

Hawkins, John Wilson who intermarried with Sarah Hawkins and who is properly authorised to act as attorney for Isaac Hawkins and Seth Wilson who intermarried with Martha Hawkins, and Joshua Paulk who intermarried with Phebe Hawkins, and we have appointed Isaac Gregory and Jonathan Hawkins our attorneys, 20 Nov 1816. John Hawkins (Seal), Benjamin Hawkins (Seal), Amos Hawkins (Seal), John Wilson (Seal), Joshua Paulk (Seal), Wit: John Gage Jr, James McKibbin. Proved by the oath of John Gage Junr 20 Nov 1816 before J. McKibbin, J.Q. Recorded 19 Jan 1818.

No known records exist of the old Hawkins home pictured here in 1914. The original hewn 18-inch pine logs secured by wooden pegs stood near Tinker Creek about three miles south of Union. The likely date: the mid to late 1700's probably built by Isaac Hawkins. His son Jonathan's family occupied the house next and either he or his son Benjamin, who next occupied it, moved the house, but for the chimney, piece by piece about 2 miles to its present location on higher ground to get away from mosquitoes and the threat of malaria. Roman numerals were cut into each log to indicate its exact location when reassembling. I was born in Australia, my greatgrandfather John Hawkins, having emigrated from Buckinghamshire in 1849. In fact the family preserved his ship's discharge papers to show he wasn't a convict! He worked his passage as a butcher, landing at Melbourne. The ship, the "Randolph", did carry convicts but the locals refused to allow them ashore and forced them to be taken on to Sydney.
