

CORYELL CEMETERY_Marian twp.-Jennings co.

This cemetery is located on State Road # 250, just east of the county line, road. Between first and second house on the North side of the road about 200 yard, north from the highway.

This cemetery is located in marian twp. on lower Cana road from TOBIAS FORD BRIDGE. Go west almost to the County-line and on the North side of road near where road turns west--out in field. Farm belongs to a Mr. Blair, whose grandmother was a MONTGOMERY, for which this cemetery is known.
