ORIGIN

Alexander Nisbet in his heraldry states ¹that Nisbet of Carfin is a branch of the Nisbets of Greenholme a family of good standing in the shire of Ayr descended of Nisbet of that Ilk

As this was heraldry this supposition may have been based on the fact of the similarity of their arms

(I wonder if this is not the case with Dirleton Dean and Craigtinnie and they may be another DNA group as he connected families by arms not genealogy)



DNA testing has neither proven or disproven this claim as yet *(no known descendants from ancestors of Greenholm before 1500 are known and will possibly never be found)*

(There has been some from DNA group2 that unfortunately had errors in their ancestry lines that that have led to Group2 being designated from Greenholm, so Alexander could still be right and Greenholm was descended from Nisbet of that Ilk)

Greenholm may have 2 different DNA groups. Greenholm in the 1500's was inherited by James an only living son and he had no issue *(probably only son but if he had any brothers they would already have deceased with no issue or they or their issue would have inherited after him)* After the death of James, Greenholm was inherited by his oldest sister Margaret. She married John Nisbet of Braidley, and if he did not descend from the original male Greenholm line, he would start a new DNA group for Greenholm.

We have now found a known descendant from Robert Nisbet of Greenholm x bef 1689 Barbara Nisbet that is being tested (This Robert N x bef 1689 Barbara N is almost certainly descended from above John Nisbet of Braidley and Margaret Nisbet of Greenholm)

That the Nisbets of Carfin is a branch of Greenholm cannot be proven from known documents and DNA testing has not proven or disproven this claim. I have found no proven Carfin descendants at this time that could be DNA tested to prove or disprove any connection.

(There has been some from DNA group2 that unfortunately had errors in their ancestry lines that lead to Group2 being from Carfin or Greenholm. This was taken as proof that Greenholm and Carfin were from same DNA group) I believe that Nisbet of Cairnhill quite possibly, may also have common ancestors with Carfin

Carfin and Ladyton was not original Nisbet property and was all sold by 1845

LADYTOUN OVERMUIR and CARLINGCRAIGS acquired ca 1631 James Nisbet from Alex. Hamilton

was acquired about 1631 by **James Nisbet** through his wife **Jean Hamilton** on a disposition from Alexander Hamilton of Ladytoun²

A gravestone in Raphoe Co Donegal Ireland⁹. This stone mentions Jean Hamilton wife to James Neesbitalso John & Andrew sons of ?? who died 1645 and JA Neesbit (*this was possibly James Nisbett son of Alexander Nisbet Ladietoun apprenticed with John Hamilton apothecary*)¹⁰ grandson to the said John died 26 Feb 1696

If this James Neesbit x Jean Hamilton are parents of James of Ladytoun and Archibald of Carfin then John and Andrew would not be their brothers as John + 1645 had a grandson so he had to have been already married with a least a child in 1645 and would have been older than Archibald * 1631. His grandson who died in 1696 *possibly James Nisbett son of Alexander Nisbet Ladietoun apprenticed with John Hamilton apothecary mentioned above* should then have inherited Ladytoun after James in 1681

George Nisbet of Redding and son Robert are mentioned in Sasine in 1633¹⁶ for James Nisbet and Jean Hamilton for property Ladyton, Overmuir, and Carlingcraigs

There is an Agnes Nisbet (* aft 1612 dau of Alexander N of Greenholm and Isobel McMeath) who was married to Robert Nisbet son of George Nisbet of Redding

BLACKSHEEP, SCANDALS? AND OTHER INTERESTING FACTS OF CARFIN

When researching I always find that in most family trees a lot of the negative family history is left out.

It is this information that fills in boring names and dates, makes a family history more interesting and has always fascinated me that it has survived.

Our ancestors were people, both good and bad, unfortunately the good is often difficult to find in any documentation and a scandal at one point of time or place, would not be a considered a scandal at another place or time period.

Divorce proceeding 1758 Archibald NISBET III of Carfin x Emilia PROVEN

Archibald NISBET III of Carfin born ca 1701/2 married by consent to Emilia PROVEN whom he was in process of divorcing 24 Feb 1758¹⁹

Only 9 months after the process of divorce is registered Emilia died²⁰ age 58, burial registered at Glasgow 2 Nov 1758, no cause of death is given, but was referred to as spouse of Archibald of Carfin This left him with 5 children from age 6 up to 14 years old.

He remarried Elizabeth Wiseman +31 May 1797²¹ her Testament 24 Aug 1797 + Jun 1797 mentioned among their children is

1797 Walter Nisbet, writer in Edinburgh who was much in debt and in Canongate prison

He could be released if he wanted if he signed a trust disposition putting his property up as security for his debt, which he refused.

This Walter's son Archibald definitely fell out of grace with Archibald V of Carfin

(The will of Archibald V of Carfin (with numerous codicils) his ½ cousin, their fathers being half brothers, both sons of Archibald III, gives us a lot of information.)

This **Archibald son of Walter**, was a painter & Glazier in Edinburgh married, with 2 children (*one named Walter other must have been a daughter or died young.*) This Archibald²² inherited 1820 after his father who + 1817, his uncle Josiah, as well as two of his aunts Margaret x Robert Burns, and Anne in 1832.

In 1835, he approached Archibald V of Carfin saying he was having financial difficulties, unable to obtain employment, and wanted money in order to immigrate to NY. He was given 50£ the 11 Feb 1835, went to Greenock, returned to Edinburgh not immigrating at all. He then left his wife 1835 and moved in with another woman. Archibald was then removed from the will.

His wife died ca 1841 and their son Walter, is described after the death of his mother by Archibald V, as “virtually an orphan” because of the “unnatural conduct of his father”. In 1842 Archibald V of Carfin writes that he had put him in an orphan hospits at the Dean where his was boarded, clothed, fed and he had paid in advance to the head master to provide for him.

Walter Nisbet Esq married Anne Parry at St Marylebone London 19 Apr 1784 and the marriage record says he was divorced but not name of first wife.

His 1st wife was Ann Blombergh who he divorced for committing adultery with Thomas Totty, esq; 1783

It is believed that Richard Nisbet *x Sophia Nisbet of Greenholm* is son of this Walter and Ann Blombergh²³

They may have had a daughter JEAN ~ 10 Dec 1648²⁷ Glasgow (*maybe a daughter of another James N x Jean Hamilton*) which then would indicate they were maybe back in Scotland. They may have moved back to Scotland from Ireland when they got Ladytoun in 1631. *Ulster Scots-Many tenant farmers came from Ayrshire - though Ireland also attracted enterprising landlords and merchants from all over Scotland. We know many had fled back to Scotland in the 1630's to avoid the Black Oath.*

People also moved in both directions at various times to avoid political problems.

They probably then lived sometime at Ladytoun and probably this James Nisbet Ladytoun (*must have been of age to borrow, so not son James of Ladytoun a young man in 1681*) who borrowed 600£ Scots with collateral 10 shilling land of Carlingcraig from James Campbell registered 2 Feb 1654²⁸

They may have returned to Ireland, leaving Ladytoun to their son James if they were buried in Ireland. (*many grave stones are erected long after the fact and include ancestors and family names as a memorial to them and they are not buried there at all.*)

They are believed to have been buried in Raphoe Co Donegal Ireland²⁹ we know they definitely lived in Ireland at some time but I have found no reference to where in Ireland. This stone (*must have been erected after 1696 so may just be a memorial for many of the names and they are not buried there at all*) mentions Jean Hamilton wife to James Neesbit (*this also may be another James N x Jean Hamilton*)also John & Andrew sons of ?? who died 1645 and JA Neesbit (*this was possibly James Nisbett son of Alexander Nisbet Ladietoun apprenticed with John Hamilton apothecary*)³⁰ grandson to the said John died 26 Feb 1696

If this James Neesbit x Jean Hamilton are parents of James and Archibald, then John and Andrew would not be their brothers. John + 1645 had a grandson so he had to have been already married with a least a child in 1645 (and would have been older than Archibald * 1631). His grandson who died in 1696 should then have inherited Ladytoun after James in 1681

How many children they had is unknown, and I have no documentation to prove without a doubt that they are definitely the parents of James and Archibald, who were brothers German (*which meant they had the same set of parents,*) their fathers name was definitely James ³¹ and were supposedly the only 2 sons according to a deed and a draft for a land charter (signature.) *In a deed John Inglis married to Catherine dtr of Archibald N I Carfin also says Archibald N was only brother german of James N of Ladytoun*

Draft 24 Nov 1693 Reg 28 Jun 1694 Signature of Infefitment of the lands of Ladytoun and--- Dec 1693 mentions Archibald of Carfin gets liferent of his son Archibald also mentions Archibald Nisbet as only brother and apparent heir to the said deceased James Nisbet of Ladytoun and as apparent heir of line of conquest and provisions to the land as was had by their father deceased James Nisbet (This is a very long document) ³²

James has been believed to have been the oldest living son at the time of his fathers death, as he got Ladytoun, did James inherit as 2nd living son and younger than Archibald as this was his mothers and not his fathers property?

According to heritancy laws in Scotland, as heritancy decends Ladytoun should then go to next brother born after James and if he had no younger brothers or their issue living at time of his death would then go to oldest. Archibald was the oldest living son and only living brother in 1681 and would have to have been older than James who at the time of his death in 1681 was a called "young man" if he was older than Archibald who was suppose to have been born in 1631 than he would have been over 50 and not what I would consider a young man.

What did Archibald inherit from his parents, and probably sold, to have money to buy Carfin in 1677?




If he took over Ladytoun after his parents we would then think him to have been the oldest living son and would have to have been born before his brother Archibald who was born in 1631³³

Is **there an error here?** James that died 1681 was a **young man** and only brother German to Archibald of Carfin. Did James inherit as 2nd son and younger than Archibald as this was his mothers and not his fathers property? The naming pattern for Archibald I of Carfin would give parents names as James and Jean.

Sasine 1681 James of Ladytoun and his testament was registered 29 Mar 1690 by his brother german Archibald of Carphin and says James died 16 February 1681 and was a young man and unmarried³⁴



I have seen this **James erroneously given as an ancestor** in diverse family trees among others (DNA2 James NISBET, born 1770 in Ayrshire, Scotland; died 1830 in Newton Co, GA. married to Sarah Frew 1789 in Belfast, Ireland.)

He is also often listed as James NISBET, born 1633 in Scotland; died 1681 in Scotland son of James NISBET and Jean HAMILTON and **in error the James Nisbet married to Ellespeth Redpeth.**

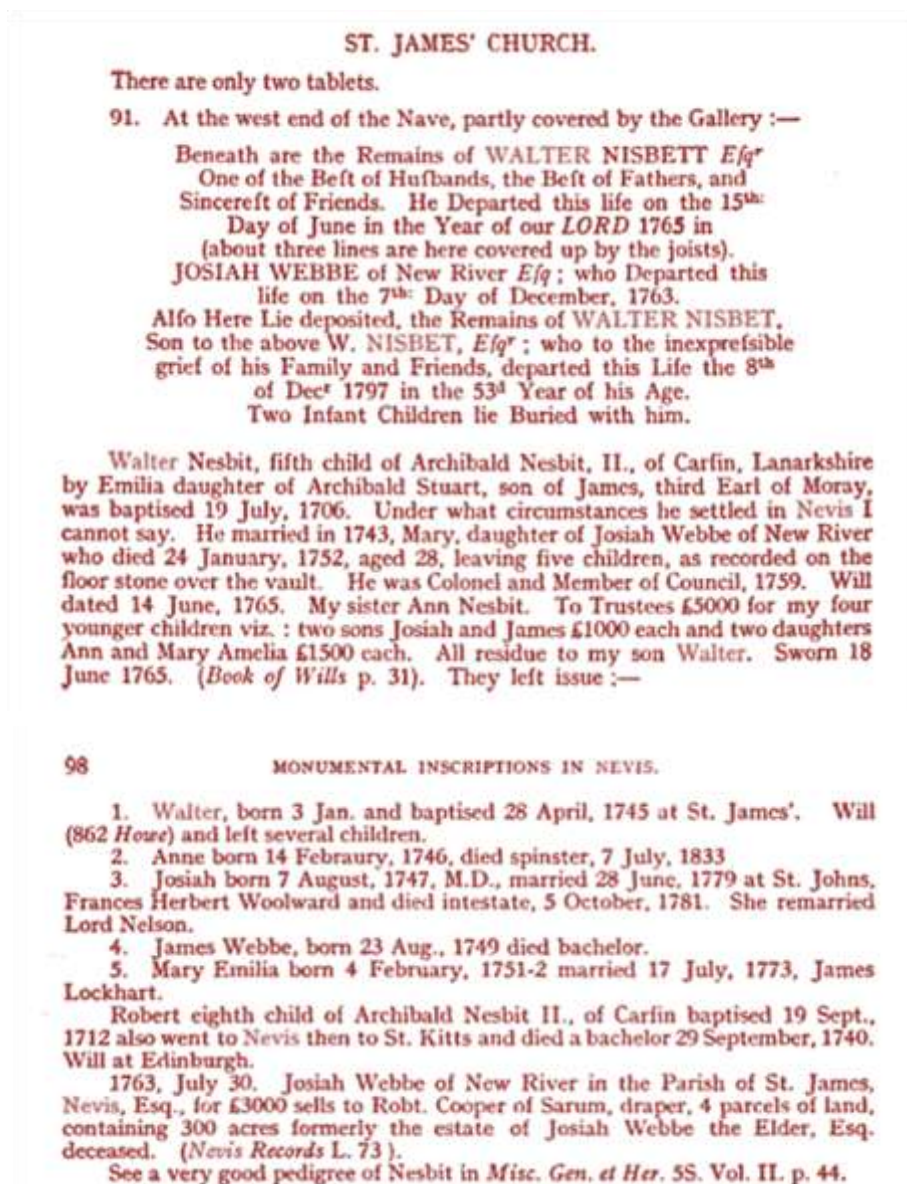

History of Nisbet Plantation

Nevis personifies just about everyone's fantasy of a palm-fringed tropical isle, still as yet unspoiled by overdevelopment. And its romantic history speaks to lovers across the ages.....

It was here that the young British Navy Captain Horatio Nelson met Frances "Fanny" Nisbet, niece of the President of Nevis and widow of Dr. Nisbet, owner of Nisbet Plantation. He was taken by her refinement, as well as by her resourcefulness in operating a large house alone. She was, in addition, an accomplished musician and a fluent speaker of French. Nelson and Fanny quickly fell in love and were married on March 11, 1787 at Fig Tree Church on Nevis. Prince William Henry, Duke of Clarence, later to be King William IV of England and a close friend of Nelson's, gave the bride away.

A key stone, found in the ruined windmill, bears the family initials and the date 1778 is still clearly visible. At that time Nisbet Estate covered numerous acres – from the existing hotel property all the way to Newcastle village – and was run first as a sugar plantation and later, as a coconut plantation.

The inventory showed a Nursery which gave doubt to that fact that they had no issue.

I found they **actually had 2 daughters**, Margaret chr. 5 Oct 1747 Hamilton, Emilia Stewart chr. 20 Jan 1749 Edinburgh **and a son Archibald** chr. 5 Jun 1752. The marriage contract was made after they were married according to the testament and which also gives death year as 1754. The cautioner of his testament was William Nisbet weaver in Edinburgh, no doubt his brother. *According to John A Inglis he died without issue June 1753*

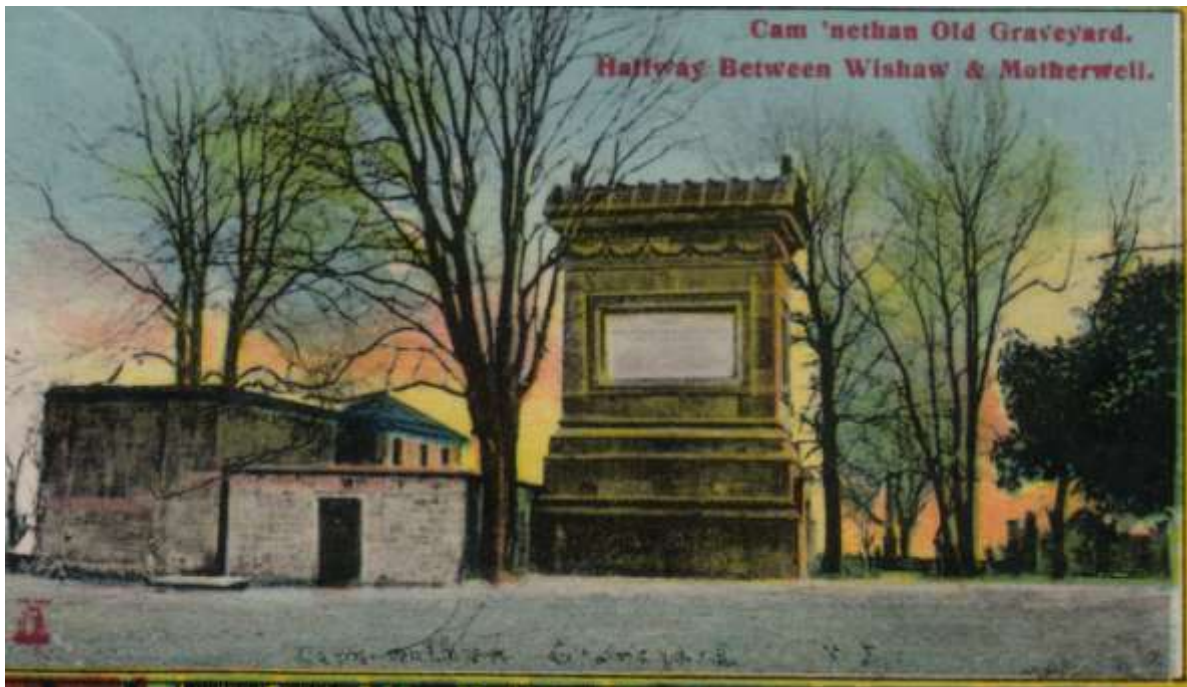

The picture below is of the old burial ground at Kirkhill, some people call it Carbarns, it was taken about 1910 and has been vandalised beyond belief since then. The large tomb (now empty) was for Lord and Lady Belhaven and Stenton. The buildings to the left (now in total ruin) were built on the site of the ancient church and were the family vaults of the Lockharts of Castlehill (lairds of Cambusnethan) and the Sommerville family.

Josiah Nisbet (1781 - 1830) - son of Francis Nisbet whom Admiral Lord Nelson married

Josiah Nisbet was born in Salisbury, England in May 1780 after his parents had arrived from the Nevis in the West Indies. His father was ill and died in his sleep in October 1781 aged 34, leaving the infant fatherless.

Josiah and his mother Frances remained in England staying with friends. They were unable to return to Nevis until French control was lost by the Treaty of Versailles 1783

Josiah fulfilled his mother's dearest wishes for grandchildren when, after marrying Frances Evans in March 1819 he started a family, becoming the father of seven children between 1821 and 1830.

In July 1830 Josiah was unwell with a heavy summer cold which developed into pleurisy or perhaps dropsy and he died on the 9th of the month Prior to this three of his children had died in France and it fell to his mother Frances, at the beginning of August, to bring the bodies of her son and his three children back to Littleham for burial. Little did she suspect that just eleven months later she would join them in the same churchyard.

There are also pecuniary legacies to each of his daughters, varying in amount, and also to his sons-in-law, goddaughter, friends, executors, and servant. The residue of his property is to be held upon trust as to one moiety for each of his daughters, Caroline Sibella and Jane Tarry, for life or until marriage; in the event of their marriage, portions are provided for them; and the ultimate residue is to go to all his five daughters. The deceased sat in the House of Commons as member for Chippenham from 1856 to 1859.
