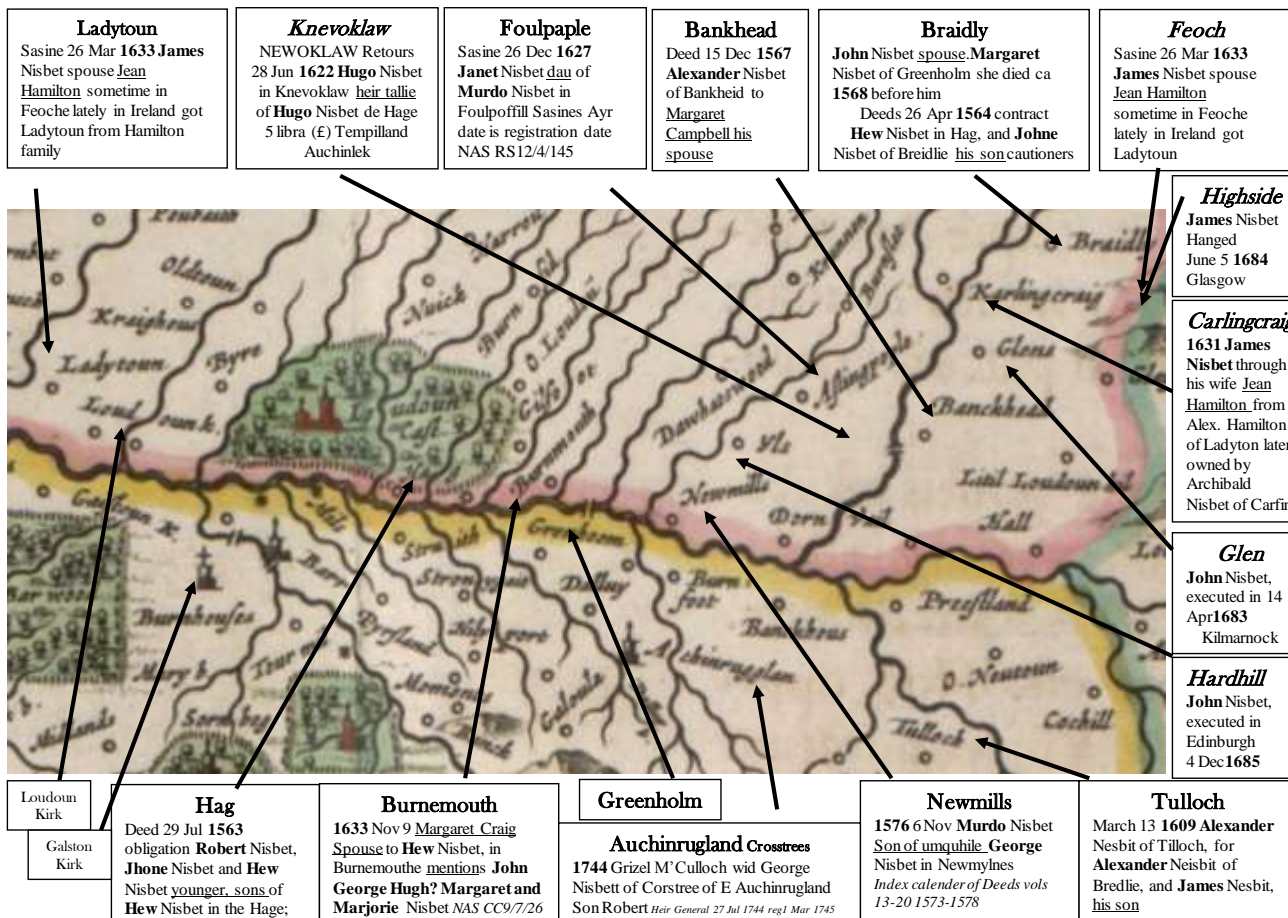

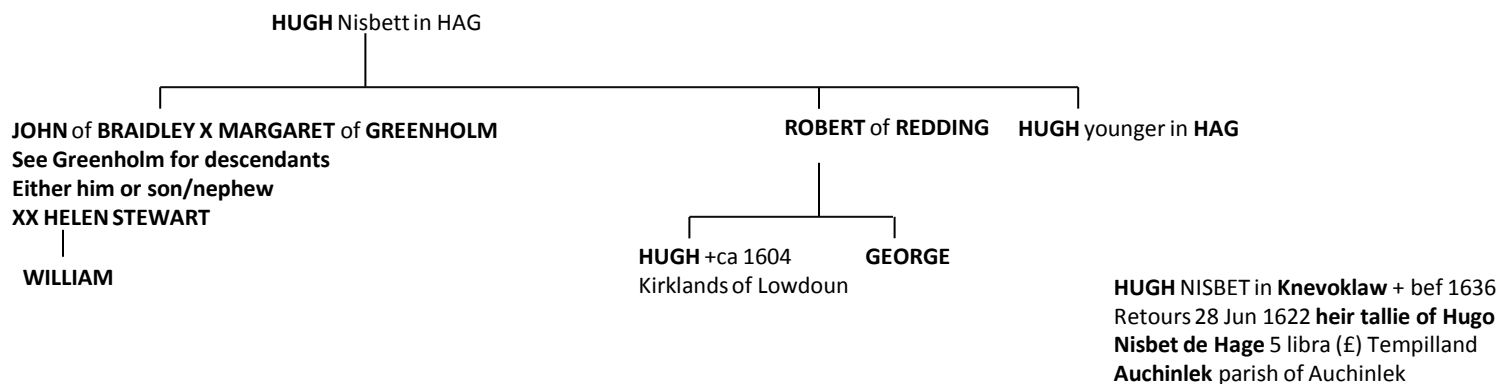

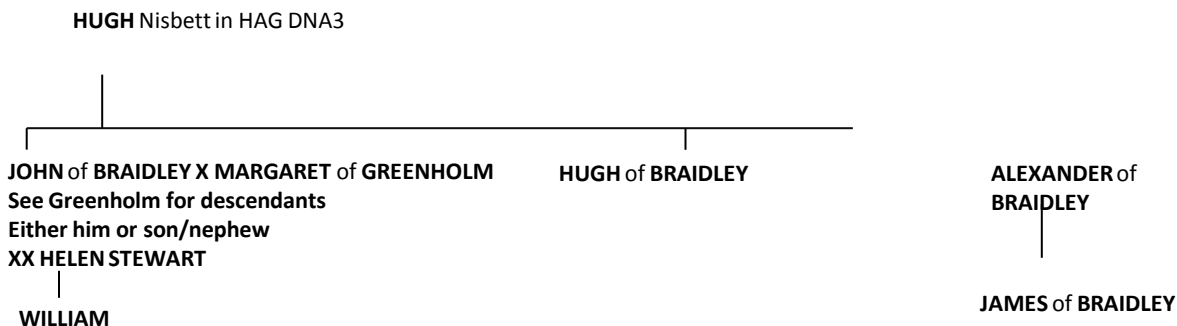

In 1609 ALEXANDER Nisbet of BRAIDLEY son is JAMES Nisbet REGISTER OF THE PRIVY COUNCIL OF SCOTLAND. Volume VIII (1607 - 1610), page 691. Dated March 13, 1609.--Hew Campbell of Auchinruglane and Alexander Nesbit of Tilloch, for Alexander Neisbit of Bredlie, and James Nesbit, his son, 200 pounds each, not to reset David Campbell of Skeldoun, or Robert Campbell in Potterstoun, rebels, conform to the charge at the instance of Jeane Crawford, Lady Crawford, and Johnne McDowell, now her spouse. The band, registered by Laurence Scot, advocate, and written by Mathew Campbell, doctor, is subscribed at the Newmylnes in Lowdown, 13 March, before Chairlis Hall in Newmylnes, George Campbell, notary, William Campbell, George Smyth, and Thomas Nicoll.

In 1626 deceased JOHN Nisbet of BRAIDLEY was married to HELEN STEWART son was WILLIAM 2 Jan Sasine to William Neisbit of an annualrent out of the lands of Dalley Registered at Irvine on the 2 January 1626. 2 December 1625, William Neisbit, son procreated between the deceased John Neisbit in Braidlie and Helen Stewart precept of sasine was written on the same day at Newmylnes In it, William Neisbit was granted an annualrent of 12 merks Scots, out of Thomas Stewart's two merklands of Stewartie Dalley, lying in Galstoun, Sasine was then given to William Neisbit who was personally present between 10 and 11 in the morning Sasines Ayr NAS RS/12/vol/3/page/472

ISABEL M'MEATH relict OF ALEX NISBET of **Greenholm** dau JONET, AGNES AND ISSOBELL Neisbits GEORGE NEISBIT, son to the deceased HEW NEISBIT in **Nevoklaw**, spouse to Jonet contract of alienation had been made between JAMES NEISBIT *fiar of Greneholme* and ALEXANDER NEISBIT and ISSOBELL MCMATH, who was then Alexander's future spouse, at Newmylne on the 13 April 1613 of his forty shilling lands of old extent of Greneholme WILLIAM NEISBIT, son of the said deceased Alexander JAMES NEISBIT, son and heir of the deceased Alexander Neisbit had now paid Issobell McMath the sum of 1,000 merks Scots and she therefore renounced her and her daughters' claim to the property signed GEORGE NEISBIT in **Dyk**, ALEXANDER NEISBIT in **Nevoklaw** Issobell McMath, her daughters and her son-in-law could not sign their names and so their hands were led at the pen by the notary (Transcription summary)

A charter containing a precept of sasine in their names had then followed. The lands were redeemable for £700 ISSOBELL MCMATH later made JAMES NEISBIT 'now of **Greinholme**', eldest son of the deceased ALEXANDER NEISBIT of **Greinholme** her cessioner and assignee with consent of JONET, AGNES AND ISSOBELL, her daughters and GEORGE NEISBIT, son of the deceased HEW NEISBIT In **Newiklaw**, spouse to Jonet.
