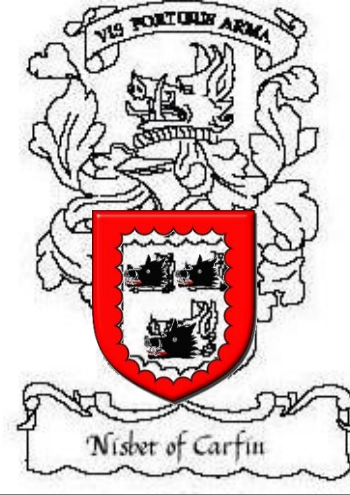

Alexander Nisbet in his heraldry states (Ed 1722 i 322) that Nisbet of Carfin is a branch of the Nisbets of Greenholme a family of good standing in the shire of Ayr descended of Nisbet of that ilk This descent cannot be proven from documents.
DNA testing has neither proven or disproven this claim. I have not found proof that Carphin is from Greenholm -----nor is there any DNA so far proven to connect to either
DNA for Carfin or Greenholm line ----lines thought to connect unfortunately had errors and no proven descent from Greenholm or Carfin
