

NISBET of Greenholm 1

JAMES NISBETT of Greenholm (* ca 1457 - + ca 1514) was granted sasine to Greenholme, Auchinruglane, Sornhill, Sorne in 1496 (Exchequer Rolls, Volume 10 (1488 - 1496) page 772)

ROBERT Nisbett of Greenholm (* bef 1485) + ca 1519 X **MARGARET BLAIR** (+ bet 1553 and 1568) only 1 son and 2 daughters

JAMES Nisbett of Greenholm (* bet 1509 and 1519) no children so his sisters inherited Greenholm after his death. Killed at the battle of Pinkie??? 14th Sept 1547?? His sasine as heir to his father 10 Apr 1533

MARIOT Nisbett Coheirress with her older sister X **JOHN LOCHART** of Bankhead

MARGARET Nisbett of Greenholm (* ca 1512) + ca 1568 coheirress with her sister by an instrument of division dated 14th Nov 1550 their fathers's lands of Greenholm & others were divided between the two sisters

x **JOHN NISBETT OF BRAIDLEY** (*ca 1512) + aft 1578 we know he was married to Margaret Nisbett of Greenholm and she had a son Alexander Nisbet

XX? **HELEN STEWART** or maybe his son was married to her (see below) Sasine 1626

WILLIAM son of John Nisbet in Braidlie Ayr Johns wife is Helen-Stewart

DNA3 is now **GREENHOLM DNA**

IF MARGARET AND JOHN ARE RELATED WHICH IS QUITE PROBABLE then Greenholm was also DNA3 before

JAMES Nisbett of Greenholm heir of Alexander also designated of Mylneside was ifeft of lands of Greenholm & others 18 Dec 1609

JAMES Nisbett of Greenholm + Oct 1680 6 Dec 1646 **Marriage contract** MARIE KENNEDY dtr of deceased James Kennedy of Blaquhyn lifesrent 40s land of Auchinrugland 20s of Greinholm and 20s 4p lands of Tulloche Sasine 8 Dec 1646 James Nisbet Greenholm future spouse is Marie Kennedy RS12/8/67 This may be a 2nd marriage of father and not of son

ROBERT Nisbett of Greenholm + Jan 1736 obtained a Charter 1681 of the lands of Greenholm & others Robert Nisbet and Barbara Nisbett his spouse reg date 8th May 1693 **FOR DESCENDANTS SEE GREENHOLM 3**

20 Nov 1693 Robert & Barbara Nisbet Greenholm SIG1-123-29 lived Sornhill paid fathers debt and got back Greenholm

Wonder if it was Barbaras families money that able him to pay fathers debt and not lose lands X bef 1681 Barbara Nisbett

Sasine 8 May 1694 Robt Nisbet of Greenholme & Barbara Nisbet his spouse of the lands of Greenholm Milnerig Milnesyde Sornhill

8 Mar 1693 Robert Nisbet Greenholm Charter by the King to Robert Nisbet of Greenholme and Barbara Nisbet his spouse which failing his nearest heirs 40s lands Greenholm-40s lands of Mylnerig-20s lands of Mylnesyde-20s lands of Sornhill that they now reside on

Also and in liferent to Barbara Nisbet 20s lands of Nether Greenholm-10s lands of Over Greenholm-40s lands of Mylnerig-20s lands of Mylnesyde

All of which heritably belonged to **deceased James Nisbet and he had borrowed money from the Hamiltons of Machlinholl. On the 2 October 1671, Anna Hamilton, daughter of John Hamilton of Machlinholl**, who was the nephew and heir of the deceased Claud Hamilton of Machlinholl, together with her husband, Robert Aichesone of Sydeserff **had brought two actions in the Court of Session to apprise the lands of Greenholme for 5,520 merks which was owed by James Nisbet.** (An apprising allowed a debtor to annexe lands to the amount of a debt owed. The debtor had 10 years to repay the debt, otherwise the creditors could retain the property) These were dated 4 October 1670 and 2 October 1671.

Apprisings could be sold on and this is what Anna Hamilton and her husband did. On the 25 April 1675, they sold the two apprisings and other related documents to John King, writer in Edinburgh and his wife for their liferent uses and to their son, William King thereafter. But on the 21 June 1675, John King sold the documents on to Heugh Archibald of Dunbeith and then he, in turn, **sold them on the 29 July 1681 to Robert Nisbet and his wife, Barbara Nisbet; hence the charter** National Archives of Scotland SIG1/126/29

Monument erected by David born 1742 married in 1773 so erected after 1773

"Sacred to the memories of Archd. Nisbet of Greenholm, Esq., descended of Nisbet of that ilk, eminent in King David the First's reign, 1126, eldest son of Robert and Barbara Nisbet, who left issue six sons and four daughters. Born 6th Oct 1689; married Elizabeth Hogg, 6th August 1727; died 25th Sept. 1764, aged 75 years. Had issue five sons and seven daughters by his wife Elizabeth, daughter of Hogg of Harcarse, who died 23rd Aug 1756, aged 46 years. Also Ann, their daughter, born 1 Nov 1732, died 20 Aug 1749, aged 16 years."
