Silvester Nuchols has been a very elusive person to find very much information on. I have found documents that show him as being a minister, and performing marriage ceremonies for several people, including more of the Nuchols Family. Of course their names were spelled several different ways.

I also have documented proof that he was witness to several estates being probated, and as a purchaser of goods being sold at these auctions. The 1810 Warren County Census shows Silvester with five males and six females in his household, along with nine slaves. Silvester Nuchols was also shown as taxed in the year of 1811, in Smith's Creek District, in North Carolina, along with a John Nuchols. In the following years however, John was still there, but Silvester was gone. We believe this is the time that he, Salley, and Thomas came to Blount County, Tennessee, and settled in the Crooked Creek Community. Courthouse documents show they were one of the first families there.

I believe that Silvester may have been a brother to the John Nuchols, that he was listed with in 1811, but have not proven this as yet. Since descendants have been told that Silvester is buried at the Crooked Creek Church Cemetery, several met there on October 1, 1990. Earl Adams dowsed for the graves and the church site. The area is just across Crooked Creek ford near Hubbard. A house once sat beside the main road, and a drive leads off in the corner of a pasture toward the church on a small hill. Two adults are buried to the left of the drive, and a cemetery containing about 15 people (mainly children) is just over the hill.

On June, 14, 1996, a Thomas Nuchols, 1215 Choctaw, Mt. Pleasant, Texas, wrote a letter, that stated that Silvester was married twice, and had thirteen children. If this is correct, then that would explain a lot of things.....

**2. Thomas<sup>2</sup> Nuchols** (Silvester<sup>1</sup>) was born 31 Aug 1795 in Warren Co, NC, and died 28 May 1874 in Blount Co, TN. He married **(1) Sarah C Kinnamon** 01 Mar 1817 in Granville Co, NC, daughter of John Kinnamon and Diza Parrish. She was born 28 Oct 1797 in Warren Co, NC, and died 14 May 1852 in Blount Co, TN. He married **(2) Mary "Polly" Waters** 26 Sep 1852 in Blount Co, TN, daughter of Enoch Waters and Mary Bird. She was born 05 Sep 1816 in KY, and died 31 Aug 1897 in Blount Co, TN.

Notes for Thomas Nuchols:

Thomas Nuchols, with his dad, Silvester Nuchols, came to Tennessee, with their wives. They traveled in what was called a tandem cart, a two-wheeled outfit with shaves, one horse between the shaves, the other horse in front attached to the shaves. There was a seat between the wheels for the two women, with some space at their feet for equipment. Other equipment was fastened to the back of the seat. The men rode horses with more equipment tied to their saddles. You can judge from the description, that this was a very scanty outfit.

There was plenty of game at that time, and they, being of hardy pioneer stock, could pretty well live off the land. They came through Cosby, to the Pleasant Grove Community, near Hubbard Community now is. Since Sally was expecting, and they had traveled many days, Thomas stopped, and moved into a vacant house, which he later bought. There was four or five hundred acres with the house. All of his children was born there, and was sold, or given portions of the land. Many of the grandchildren were born there.

There is evidence that Sally was born in Blount, through the census, but other evidence shows she was born in North Carolina. The stories I have read say she was from N.C., and that is where she was married to Thomas. Another story says she and Thomas came from Virginia, through North Carolina, to Blount County.

"My mother's cousin, Thom Nuchols, said that the father of Thomas Nuchols was Silvester Nuchols. He came to Blount County, died around 1830, and was buried in an old cemetery on Crooked Creek. Grandfather Richard volunteered for the Confederate Army; did not serve very long and he was called home because of his wife's sickness. But while in the army, he made friends by helping his army buddies write letters to their home folk. When at home, he helped the wives to write letters to their husbands in the army, because they could not read or write. History notes in the White Family describe this good deed.

Rebecca White died, in 1856, during the civil war, and Richard sold his farm during that year.

Richard possessed a legal mind; just following the civil war, he was living and working in a Veterans Home in Waynesville, North Carolina, and he helped widows secure their pensions. As a part of his work, he helped Rachel Massey Davis, (Mrs. William Davis), to secure her 1812 war pension. While helping Rachel, he met her daughter Mary Anne Davis, who became his wife in 1865.

Richard was esquire of Blount County and was a representative of Tennessee's State Legislature in 1885. he was a man of strong Christian character and his church preference was the Baptist. Nuchols and Miss Agnes Nuchols. Mrs. Nuchols wore white crepe beaded dress. Miss Agnes Nuchols wore blue handed-painted crepe dress. The many useful and beautiful gifts were on display in the parlor which was decorated with gift flowers. In the hall under a green and gold arch was Mrs. Ralph Tucker, Sr., presiding over the punch bowl. She was gowned in gold georgette beaded dress.

The dining room, where the guests were served a salad course, was beautiful in gold and green. The table was overlaid in gold and green. In the center was a gold basket on a mirror encircled by vines and golden rod and above hung from a chandelier a golden bell and streamers to each corner of the table and from the bell draped a "Cupid." The salad course served was of gold, and was served by Miss Nuchols and her Neice, Miss Louise Clemens, who wore pink Voile Costume.

The receiving hours were from 9 to 11 a.m., and from 1 to 6 p.m., and a large number of friends and relatives called during these hours and enjoyed this notable and happy occasion.

The present home of this happy couple is a block away and in view of the old home of the bride of fifty years ago who was before her marriage Miss Elizabeth S. Steele. Another interesting feature was that one guest at the wedding of this couple was also present at the anniversary celebration. "Uncle" Elijah Nuchols, the oldest member living now of the Nuchols generation. As noted earlier, Elizabeth had cancer, and at one point was very ill.

James Wesley must have been quite a character, and was pretty well known by most people, according to letters and documents available. I received copies of four letters that were written to James Hall, which was in the Civil War at the time. Two were written by Mr. Hall's wife, one from his dad, and one from George Cross. Three of the four contained information and speculation about James Wesley Nuchols. I have included some of the things pertaining to Wesley.

The first is dated May 14, 1864.

James, you wanted to know what had become of Wesley Nuchols. The reports that you have heard about Wesley out there are all false. He is not with the rebels, nor is he a bushwhacker as is reported. He was taken up by Mr. Sanderson, the provost at Maryville on the old scrape that Mr. Clark brought against him. They were taking him to Knoxville and he escaped, and is now taking care of himself the best he can. That is the most that I can tell you, but what I have said is the truth. He has never been in the army since he got away from Mr. Clark, and will not be if he can help himself.

The second one is dated May 24, 1864, from Barbara Hall to James Hall

I must tell you about West Nuchols. The yankees took him, and there were so many bad cases against him, they sent him off. And I heard yesterday that they shot him. He has done so bad, we can't expect nothing else.

The third is dated August 21, 1864, from George Cross to James Hall

Well, I guess that you would like to hear what has become of Wes Nuchols. I can tell you that his trial has been on hands for 3 or 4 weeks. I have not heard anything from him for 3 or 4 days. I think that he will be sent off to some prison up north.

Although the letters would lead a person to think that James wasn't in the war, the Blount County Genealogy Society states that Elizabeth recieved a war pension from the government for his service in Company K 5th Tennessee Calvary.

In the Maryville Times, February 23 1906, this article was printed;

J. Wesley Nuchols and Calvin Russell who have passed to their reward were both old soldiers but serving on opposing sides, Mr. Nuchols serving for the Confederacy and Mr. Russell for the Union."

Finally got up to the courthouse in Denton to get a copy of that Jim Nuckols to Lizzie Mealer marriage license. License was obtained on 6Nov1888, they were married on 6Nov1888 and the License was recored on 9Nov1888. Was disappointed in that the original application for a marriage license was not available, but instead the transcribed info into the marriage record book. I wanted to see the actual signatures but the clerk stated that the originals were never kept in that county after the info was entered into the permanent record book. I am not sure about this and will check it further.

Also, a marriage license could be obtained in Denton County by anyone, regardless of where they were from and many people would come down out of OK and get married in Denton County, Texas but she was not sure why. Also, after getting the license to marry that marriage could take place anywhere in Texas, not just Denton County and this particular marriage does not say where the marriage was held. Only that the presiding official was a J.P. by the name of Ben Moss, but it did not name the county inwhich he served.

The name of the groom was listed twice as: J. R. Nuckuols and the bride as Lizzie Mealer.

So we do know that J. R. Nuckols married Lizzie Mealer. I will do some more searching in the area soon trying to get more info on this couple.

I am still puzzled as to what happened to first husband of Lizzie, M. M. Mealer whom she married in 1886, then what happened to Jim Nuckols as she again married in 1896 to P. D. Brown.

The owners of a home on Old Piney Road could do little but watch as fire destroyed their house Saturday afternoon. Charles David Nuchols tried to comfort his wife, Peggy, who sat on the neatly clipped grass and sobbed as Blount County Fire Department personnel battled the flames consuming the Nuchols house. Friends and neighbors approached the couple, offered their sympathy and help if needed, then stepped back shaking their heads in dismay at the speed the fire was moving. Neighbors said the Nuchols have lived at the location more than 25 years and had recently made some home improvements. The well-cared-for house, lawn and flower beds were testimony to the attention the family gave their home. One of the neighbors said she noticed smoke coming from the back of the house about mid-afternoon and initially thought someone was burning trash. She said the amount of smoke seemed to be increasing rapidly, so she and her daughter drove up the road past the front of the Nuchols house. They could see flames and began yelling for other neighbors to call 911. Someone made that call and someone contacted members of the Nuchols family, all of whom were away from the house when the fire broke out. The fire was reported at 3:39 p.m. Saturday, and the first of six trucks reached the scene at 3:48 p.m. By that time, the roof and walls at both ends of the structure were in flames. Heavy black smoke continued to boil up and flames raced along the roof line as the fire consumed the house. The fire was finally brought under control just before 5 p.m. with the efforts of 15 firefighters. Firefighters were on the scene until 6:17 p.m. to make sure hot spots did not flare up. The cause of the fire had not been determined since investigators were unable to examine the ruins of the house until the rubble completely cooled.
