Will of Thomas Smith

His will was dated 29 Jun 1808 and entered into probate 11 Apr 1808.

Mentions his wife Mary, sons Samuel & Thomas Smith Jr., daughters Mary Dunning & Catharine Fuller grandchildren: Jane Ladoe, Thomas Ladoe, Stephen Ladoe the children of his daughter Neffe (Eveline) and her dec. husband Thomas Stillwell--Catherine Stillwell, Smith Stillwell, James Stillwell, Samuel Stillwell & Daniel Stillwell the children of his daughter Jerusha, dec. & her husband Solomon Taylor--Solomon Taylor Jr., Polly Taylor, Sarah Taylor, Catherine Taylor, Walter Taylor, Jerusha Taylor & Betsy Taylor.

Executors were Samuel Smith & Thomas Smith Jr.

Notes on Mary "Maria" Smith

Marriage of Maria Smith

State of New York | Fulton County

I Catharine Fuller of the Town of Galway in the County of Saratoga being duly sworn depose & say that I am aged seventy two years, that I am the sister of Maria Dunning the widow of Abel Dunning deceased, a Pensioner of the United States.

Thomas Smith and Mary

I further state that according to the best of my recollection and belief the said Abel Dunning was married to Maria Smith (now Maria Dunning the widow of said Abel Dunning) in the year 1784. I was not present at the marriage, but was at my father's house, Mr. Thomas Smith, in Pittstown, Rensselaer County, a short time before the marriage but was away about two weeks before they were married. I heard of the marriage a short time after it took place & saw them a few months after they were married and have known them ever since and they have always lived together as man and wife.

I think they were married in 1784, as I was about thirteen or fourteen years of age at the time and have known them to have lived together from that time up to the period of the death of Abel Dunning aforesaid. I recollect the time of the marriage from another circumstance, that about a month after my sister was married, my Father moved to Saratoga County which was about fifty-eight years ago.

Will was written 19 Feb 1821 and probated 23 Nov 1821 - mentions widow Polly and sons Abel, Richard, Stephen & Samuel. Does not mention daughters.
