

# Super Thrill Hell Drivers In Fair Here

A wild daring exhibition of hell driving up and over rampways on two wheels at a mile a minute pace with skilled daredevils "riding the ramps" in breath-taking fashion, narrowly averting collisions as they ride in precision style, will serve as an "eye-opener" to even greater thrills when B. Ward Beam's combined Congress of Daredevils and World's Champion Hell Drivers provide Fair patrons with 90 minutes of reckless thrills in front of the grandstand at the Indiana County Fair, Indiana, Saturday afternoon and night August 31st.

The feature event is the climax to this super-thriller—a long distance car leap with a daredevil clinging to the steering wheel over a trans-continental bus—a stunt that has taken the lives of five famous daredevils in recent years, including the late "Lucky Teter, beloved king of motor mad daredevils.
