WILLIAM¹ YOUNG, b. Scotland in 1809. He m. JANE (JENNIE) McLAM, (born Scotland in 1811); they came to America on their Honeymoon; her parents and their 11 children came too, along with William' s brothers, James & John.

Old maps show that John and James settled on the southwest side of Cow Hill. In my time the families lived on the east side of the hill. The houses have long been gone but the land is owned by Hilary Smith. The Proctors own the land on the east side of the Cow Hill Road that was also a part of the Youngs' holdings.

They had six children: Catherine (Katie); John' s widow, Phebe; and James are the only ones that I remember - Alex and his 1st & 2nd wife and John had died earlier.

James, or Jimmy, as he was called; and his sister, Kate lived back from the Cow Hill Road.

v. John' s widow, Phebe, lived nearer the road. She was the last to carry on the farm, aided by hired men and "hangers on". She was a kind and generous woman who fed and housed "strays".

iv. Alex married MARTHA FARROW, they had a son, Charles and in April 1872 were expecting another child. She was following us as I remember the story from my mother, Mary Craig.

How they got word to Dr. Parker, she never said, but he could only get his horse and sleigh as far as the place now owned by Dr. Smith and went up the hill on snow shoes.

He delivered twins, one lived, but the other baby and the mother died.

The casket for the burial had to be taken up the hill and brought back down on a hand sled. The baby and the mother were buried together.

The first child, Charles, grew up, got his education at C.C.S.S. Peacham Academy, went to New York where he worked on a newspaper until he died of pneumonia at the age of 22.

Jennie, the twin that lived, married Lewis Dana.

When I was a child, 1902-1903, attending school in Ewell' s Hollow, they lived in the house now owned by Philip Dawson.

Alex married second MELVINA HUNT and they had two children.

I do not know whether there are any relatives of these families left, but the Young family was once a part of Peacham.

This hand-written letter about the Young family was found in Daphne Quimby's copy of People of Peacham.
