HISTORY OF BARNET, VERMONT.

RUSSELL.

JOHN,¹ b. at Bridgeton, near Glasgow, Scotland 1762. Grocer and shoemaker in Bridgeton; m. Mary Schlitzer of that place. Came to Quebec 1803; to Barnet 1804, with his son, John; the rest of the family came several years later. Bought the farm where Joseph Cummings lived in 1860. He d. 1838, and she in 1850; buried in Danville.

- I. Janet,² b. 1787; m. Abel Houghton of Barnet.
- II. Agnes,² b. 1790; m. William Wilson of Campbell field, near Glasgow.
- III. John,² b. 1793. Went west and never returned.
- IV. Margaret,² b. ab. 1796; m. Feb. 7, 1821 James² son of Hugh¹ and Helen (Sproat [Pratt[LDS]]) Somers, q. v. (p. 616); rem. Danville 1827; she d. July 26, 1825 [gs]; both bur. Danville Green.
- V. James,² b. 1803; res. Danville; m. March 23, 1830 Nancy³ Somers (b. Barnet March 28, 1808; d. Danville Apr. 5, 1881) dau. "Black Bart" and Agnes (Trumbull) Somers, q. v. (p. 615).
