VITTY.

JOHN PAGE VITTY, the son of Albert and Dolly (Phipps) Vitty, born N. H. [1870 census] May 23, 1831 [dc]; he m. Eliza Jane (b. N. H. [1870 census] Dec. 29, 1833; d. Aug. 5, 1917) dau. Jeremiah and Patience (Osborn) Martin [dc]. John came to Passumpsic from Claremont, N. H. in 1865, and was section foreman on the Boston & Maine R. R. nearly 40 years. He d. May 26, 1914 [dc]. John, his wife, and their parents were all born in Weare, N. H.; John and Eliza died at Passumpsic and are buried there [dc^s].

Children:

I. Etta Jane,² [mc] b. Weare, N. H. [mc] Jan. 13, 1856; m. Barnet April 3, 1879 [BVRmr] as 1st wife of Frank Cyrus⁵ Somers. She d. May 1, 1883 [dc/gs]; bur. Passumpsic with infant dau., Nellie Etta [gs] who d. April 25, 1883 aged 1 day [dc], q. v. (p. 611).

II. Lucian Harry,² [son Frank bc] b. Claremont, N. H. [mc] May 12, 1864; m. Passumpsic May 12, 1891 [mc] Jennie Elizabeth⁴ (b. June 4, 1868) dau. Claudius³ and Janette¹ (Samuel) Somers, q. v. (p. 614). Attended Passumpsic Village School winter 1880/81 and signed teacher's autograph album, q.v. (Hist.Soc.collection). Railroad Baggage Master [mc] then Passenger Conductor [dau.bc] on B. & M. R. R. many years. Owned the house at the foot of the hill on the east end of the dam in 1914, and "Hill Haven" at the top of the hill, 1914-1920 [BLR]. Members, with their children, of the Baptist Church at Passumpsic, in which he was a deacon, q. v. (p. 614).

1. Clarence Lucian,³ b. Nov. 17, 1896 [bc]. Graduated St. Johnsbury Academy 1916 and Norwich University 1920. Rem. Florida.

3. Nettie Charlotte,³ b. Jan. 18, 1908 [bc].
