From the Paisley Advocate, Jan 25, 1906, pg 1 col 3 at the bottom of the page:

-Owen Sound Sun: Mrs. Elizabeth Walker passed quietly away on Thursday at the home of her granddaughter, Mrs. W. J. Barnhart, Jackson. Death resulted from ailments of old age. Deceased was married to the late Thomas Walker, and for years resided in the village of Sydenham, Peel county. Her husband predeceased her 45 years ago and for nearly forty years she lived with her daughter, Mrs. John Pearce, of Paisley. A year and a half ago she came to live with her son. Mr. Thomas Walker, Union st. hill, and four months ago went to spend some time with Mr. Walker's daughter, Mrs. Barnhart, where she passed away. Deceased was in her 88th year and was a lifelong member of the Methodist. church. She leaves three children, Mrs. John Pearce, Paisley; Mrs. Wm. Briggs, Calgary; Mr. Thos. Walker, Owen Sound. The funeral took place on Friday to Greenwood cemetery. The services were conducted by the Rev. P. McNab, of Kilsyth.

Notes for THOMAS WALKER:

In 1838, a Thomas Walker is living in Trafalgar at lot 5, Concession 10 (200 acres, 60 cultivated). There are 2 males over 16, 2 under 16, 1 female over 16, and 1 female under 16. This could be our man if his father or other relative was staying with them. The same lot has other tenants before and after this year.

The 1837 Directory for Home District shows two Thomas Walkers living in Toronto Twp. One is in the Old Survey at con N1 lot 9 and the other in the New Survey at con 5 lot 5.

Notes for MOSES CHRISTOPHER JOHNSON:

In the 1891 census entry, his father is given as born in England and his mother as born in Wales. Both are known to be true.

The Southampton Circuit records Moses & Mrs. Johnston as "received from Tara" some time after June 1891 when it was formed. They are again recorded in 1898 and about 1904, the latter time with their daughters Keturah and Mary. This last entry is why I believe that this is not Moses, senior. In 1908 Minnie (Minerva) and Nebbie (Annetta) are added to the list.

They are listed again in the 1911/12 list for Elsinore. Here it is noted that Mrs. Johnston died in Apr 1914.
